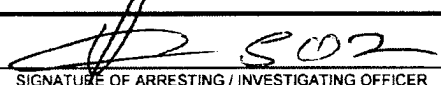

While traveling eastbound on Northlake Blvd, I observed a black BMW, bearing Florida tag PCCA97. A DHSMV records check on the vehicle revealed that the registered owner of the vehicle had a suspended driver's license. I activated my emergency lights to initiate a traffic stop as the suspect vehicle proceeded eastbound passing Hiatt Dr, the driver began to accelerate at which point I activated my vehicle lights and siren. The suspect vehicle turned right onto Kelso Dr and came to a final stop at the entrance of Horseshoe Acres. The suspect vehicle traveled a total distance of 1.35 miles from the time my emergency lights and sirens were activated until it came to a stop. My department-issued body-worn camera was utilized during the duration of this investigation.								
	While walking toward the car, I observed movements inside the vehicle. It looked to me that the driver was putting something under the driver's seat. I also observed the driver and the sole occupant of the vehicle dropping a dollar bill behind the passenger seat. Through my training and experience, I know that it is common in street-level narcotics to roll-up dollar bills for "snorting" (ingesting through the nostrils) of narcotics. I made contact with the driver, which was identified via his Florida Driver's License as Adam Daniel Rockoff (08/08/1982). I advised Rockoff of the reason for the traffic stop and requested he provide me with his driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance for the vehicle. While getting the license from Rockoff, I noticed a plastic bag on the floor next to his right foot and near the center console. From the outside of the vehicle, the bag appears to be approximately 10 inches long containing a green leafy substance. I also smelled, what based on my training and experience, I immediately identified as the odor of marijuana and alcohol. 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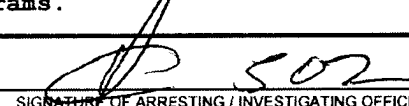

In front of the front passenger seat, Ofc. Paquette located a black and gray backpack. Inside the backpack I located 29 rectangular-shape pills, identified via Drugs.com as Alprazolam, schedule:4 control substance which Rockoff does not have a prescription for. 61 round-shape pills identified via Drugs.com as Oxycodone Hydrochloride, schedule:2 control substance which Rockoff does not have a prescription for. 33 Capsule -shape pills and 5 round -shape pills identified via Drugs.com as Acetaminophen and Oxycodone Hydrochloride, schedule:2 control substance which Rockoff does not have a prescription for. 8 yellow and 1 purple pill were field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for MDMA. Ofc. Paquette also found a cylindrical shaped tube (straw). Through my training and experience, I know that it is common in street-level narcotics to use straws for "snorting" (ingesting through the nostrils) of narcotics. Inside the same bag, I also located several Ziploc bags containing a green leafy looking substance which through my training and experience, knew to be consistent with the description of the street drug known as marijuana. Through my training and experience, I also know that it is common in street-level narcotics to store drugs on small Ziploc bags for individual sales. The green leafy substance was field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for Marijuana. The total package weight of the suspected marijuana was 420.7 grams (.92 lbs.). 12 Stoney patch edibles cannabis candies, 13 edibles cannabis, 1 chocolate edibles cannabis, and 7 suspected THC cartridges. While weighting the suspected marijuana, it was discovered that one of the bags contained what based on my training and experience knew to be consistent with the description of the street drug known as Psilocybin Mushrooms. The total package weight of the suspected Psilocybin Mushrooms was 13.4 grams.

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Inside the same bag, I also located five (5) plastic bags containing the white powdery substance, based on my training and experience, appeared to be cocaine. The white powdery substance was field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for cocaine. Inside Rockoff's wallet, Ofc. Sheobo (ID524) located a plastic bag containing the white powdery substance, based on my training and experience, appeared to be cocaine. The white powdery substance was field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for cocaine. Inside a black fanny pack, I located 2 plastic bags containing the white powdery substance, based on my training and experience, appeared to be cocaine. The white powdery substance was field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for cocaine. The total weight of the suspected cocaine was 3.8 grams.

A further search yielded in locating 3 cell phones which through my training and experience, I also know that it is common in street-level narcotics for dealer to carry several cell phones in local dealings. The 3 cell phones were entered into evidence.

Post-Miranda warnings Rockoff refused to answer questions but claimed ownership of the money. It should be noted that inside Rockoff wallet, a bag of cocaine was found together with 2 Visa Cards with Rockoff's name printed on, which is the same name in the Florida Driver's License that Rockoff provided to this officer.

All contrabands were packaged appropriately and submitted into the Palm Beach Gardens evidence department as evidence.

Based on the above facts, probable cause exists to arrest Adam Daniel Rockoff with;

- 1 Count for Trafficking Oxycodone pursuant to F.S.S.893.135(1) (c) (1) (b) ;
- 1 Count for Possession of MDMA with intent to sell. F.S.S. 893.13(1) (A) ;
- 1 Count for possession of Cocaine with intent to sell F.S.S. 893.13(1) (a) ;
- 1 Count for Trafficking Alprazolam pursuant to F.S.S. 893.135(1) (c) (1) ;
- 1 count of Possession of Marijuana with intent to sell. F.S.S. 893.13(1) (A) (2) ;
- 1 count of Possession of Psilocybin Mushrooms with intent to sell. F.S.S. 893.13(1) (A) ;
- 1 Count for Possession of THC with intent to sell. F.S.S. 893.13(6) (A) ;

The \$6,977.00 US dollars were seized and Rockoff was provided with a copy of the forfeiture form which was discussed and explained to Rockoff.

Rockoff was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident. A tracking citation was included in this arrest.

Inside the backpack I located 29 rectangular-shape pills, identified via Drugs.com as Alprazolam, schedule:4 control substance which Rockoff does not have a prescription for. 61 round-shape pills identified via Drugs.com as Oxycodone Hydrochloride, schedule:2 control substance which Rockoff does not have a prescription for. 33 Capsule -shape pills and 5 round -shape pills identified via Drugs.com as Acetaminophen and Oxycodone Hydrochloride, schedule:2 control substance which Rockoff does not have a prescription for. 8 yellow and 1 purple pill were field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for MDMA. Ofc. Paquette also found a cylindrical shaped tube (straw). Through my training and experience, I know that it is common in street-level narcotics to use straws for "snorting" (ingesting through the nostrils) of narcotics. Inside the same bag, I also located several Ziploc bags containing a green leafy looking substance which through my training and experience, knew to be consistent with the description of the street drug known as marijuana. Through my training and experience, I also know that it is common in street-level narcotics to store drugs on small Ziploc bags for individual sales. The green leafy substance was field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for Marijuana. The total package weight of the suspected marijuana was 420.7 grams (.92 lbs.). 12 Stoney patch edibles cannabis candies, 13 edibles cannabis, 1 chocolate edibles cannabis, and 7 suspected THC cartridges. While weighting the suspected marijuana, it was discovered that one of the bags contained what based on my training and experience knew to be consistent with the description of the street drug known as Psilocybin Mushrooms. The total package weight of the suspected Psilocybin Mushrooms was 13.4 grams.

Sheobo (ID524) located a plastic bag containing the white powdery substance, based on my training and experience, appeared to be cocaine. The white powdery substance was field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for cocaine. Inside a black fanny pack, I located 2 plastic bags containing the white powdery substance, based on my training and experience, appeared to be cocaine. The white powdery substance was field-tested using a NARK II field test kit and yielded a presumptive positive for cocaine. The total weight of the suspected cocaine was 3.8 grams. A further search yielded in locating 3 cell phones which through my training and experience, I also know that it is common in street-level narcotics for dealer to carry several cell phones in local dealings. The 3 cell phones were entered into evidence. Post-Miranda warnings Rockoff refused to answer questions but claimed ownership of the money. It should be noted that inside Rockoff wallet, a bag of cocaine was found together with 2 Visa Cards with Rockoff's name printed on, which is the same name in the Florida Driver's License that Rockoff provided to this officer. All contrabands were packaged appropriately and submitted into the Palm Beach Gardens evidence department as evidence.
