On April 17th, 2021 at approximately 1852 hours, I Officer Zach Hoppe of the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, was on routine water patrol near Williams Park, Tampa, Florida. I observed a 20-foot blue center console with five males on board heading towards the Williams Park Boat Ramp. I identified myself as a Law Enforcement Officer and informed the men that we would be doing a vessel safety inspection. I observed the operator, who I actively observed operating the vessel. I identified him as Adrian P. Keel via his valid Florida Driver License (K400-015-95-121-0). To pserved Mr. Keel's eyes to be blood shot and glassy and his words to be slurred. I instructed Mr. Keel to retrieve his required US Coast Guard safety gear. Through out retrieving the required safety equipment I observed Mr. Keel have difficulty wilking from the front to rear of the vessel, continuously bracing. I also observed Mr. Keel have difficulty using his fingertips and fine dexterity. When Mr. Keel handed me his fire extinguisher I observed the overwhelming odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth. I asked Mr. Keel if he had any alcoholic beverages and he advised he had not. Due to the aforementioned clues of impairment, I asked Mr. Keel to submit to a series of standardized field sobriety tasks (herein referred to as SFSTs) in order to check to see if he was fit to operate her vessel. I had Mr. Keel sit on a cooler just forward of the center console on my patrol vessel. I asked Mr. Keel if the cooler was stable in his opinion. Mr. Keel advised that it was. I began with the General instructions of the SFSTs and read the instructions verbatim from the Seated battery of SFSTs pre-printed card.  Mr. Keel showed 6 clues on HGN in which the evaluation criteria was four or more clues. On finger to nose he demonstrated 9 clues in which the evaluation criteria 9 or more. Next he performed palm pat where he demonstrated 2 clues in which the criteria was 2 or more. On the last task of hand coordination he demonstrated 4 clu
