The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did: On 09/27/2020, at approximately 0214 hours, the affiant was traveling northbound on John Moore Rd and observed a black Hyundai Sonata, bearing Florida tag LFMX39 (VIN:5NPE24AF9KH741182), to be traveling in front of his patrol vehicle.
