The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On 09/27/2020, at approximately 0214 hours, the affiant was traveling northbound on John Moore Rd and observed a black Hyundai Sonata, bearing Florida tag LFMX39 (VIN:5NPE24AF9KH741182), to be traveling in front of his patrol vehicle. The affiant observed the vehicle weaving within it's lanes, braking randomly, and fluctuating its speed. The affiant conducted stop on the vehicle to check on the well being of the driver to see whether they were ill, tired, or impaired. Upon contact with the defendant, the affiant detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath, his eyes to be red/bloodshot and watery, and his speech to be slurred. The affiant requested the defendant to perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSEs), which he agreed to do. During the SFSEs, the defendant show multiple indicators of impairment and was subsequently arrested for DUI. The defendant was transported to CBT, where after a proper 20 minute observation period was conducted, he agreed to provide two lawful samples of his breath. Breath technician A. Montgomery (ABN:45673) provided the affiant with the results and they are as follows: first BrAC sample .210%, second BrAC sample .209%. The defendant was positively identified via his valid Florida driver's license.
