The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On the above listed date and time at the above listed location, Deputy Frankowski #260035, conducted a traffic stop on a silver Ram bearing Florida tag: CUIA13, due to the vehicle almost hit his patrol vehicle. Upon making contact with the defendant, Deputy Frankowski observed signs of impairment. I responded to the scene and detected the defendant to have glassy and bloodshot eyes, slurred speech, very unsteady on his feet, and a distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath. I requested the defendant to perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSEs), which the defendant agreed to perform. During the exercises, the defendant showed multiple signs of impairment and was subsequently arrested for DUI. The defendant agreed to provide two lawful breath samples to determine his breath alcohol content (BrAC). After a proper 20 minute observation period was conducted, the defendant provided two lawful samples of his breath. First BrAC sample (.189): Second BrAC sample (.194). The defendant received a DUI citation #AE94SAE, which reflects the DUI charge. The defendant was identified via his Florida Driver's License.
