PROBABLE CAUSE STATEMENT	On Monday, March 1, 2021 at approximately 1900 hours, I responded to the 700 Block of Northlake Boulevard (Bv), in the City of Lake Park (Palm Beach County) Florida to assist Deputy Oscar Trinidad with a traffic crash that involved a possible drunk driver. Upon my arrival I noticed the crash scene was clear and the vehicles involved were removed from the scene. I saw a white female subject sitting on a concrete slab with D/S Trinidad accompanying her. I made contact with D/S Trinidad who worked the crash. He told me the following: On 3-1-2021 at approximately 1844 hours I responded to the 800 block of Northlake Blvd Lake Park in reference to a motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival, I observed a black Honda Civic FL tag # ELXI93 parked in the far right lane at the 800 block of Northlake Blvd. I activated my emergency lights to my marked patrol vehicle and approached the driver's side of the vehicle. I observed that the vehicle was disabled and had severe front-end damage. I observed a female later identified as Alexia Lanza sitting in the front driver seat and the vehicle running. I attempted to open the driver's door to check the welfare of Lanza and found the door to be locked. Lanza then unlocked the door, opened it, and stated someone had hit her vehicle and fled the scene. I then advised Lanza to shut the vehicle off and exit due to the vehicle still being on the roadway (for safety reasons). I observed Lanza had bloodshot eyes and were glassy appearance. The vehicle had a very strong odor of an unknown flowery perfume. I also observe when Lanza spoke she had slurred speech and appeared to be lethargic. Lanza exited the vehicle and her breast were exposed. I told Lanza to fix her top because she was exposing herself. I then asked Lanza if she had any injures. Lanza fixed her top and stated she was not injured. I told Lanza that I will call for an Ambulance due to the airbag deploying. Lanza begged me not to call for an ambulance and stated she was fine. I did not observe any physical injuries. I was then flagged down by Robert Hayes who was in the parking lot of 836 Northlake Blvd. Hayes stated he was traveling east on Northlake Blvd. Hayes stated he turned on his right turning signals to make a right hand turn onto Popular Ct and Northlake Blvd and was rear-ended by the black Honda Civic. I observed Hayes was driving a red Buick four-door sedan FL tag # 1RANDR1. I observed the rear end of the red Buick and observed the rear bumper was damaged and partially on the ground. Hayes provided me with his Driver's license, insurance, and registration. Based on the above facts and statement it appeared that Lanza was under the influence. I called for a DUI unit to conduct an investigation for impairment.

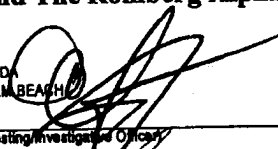

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	D/S White arrived on scene shortly after and took over the investigation. I completed a motor vehicle accident report case # 21-040674. I also was able to obtain video surveillance of the motor vehicle accident from 836 Northlake Blvd. Lake Park (The Lab Salon Suites) of the motor vehicle accident: He wrote a sworn witness statement on a probable cause affidavit detailing his involvement with this case. I made contact with the driver who was currently sitting on the concrete slab. She was later identified as Alexia Gennesis Lanza by her Florida driver license. Her eyes were red, watery and glossy. Her cheeks were flushed, mouth dry and she slurred her speech while speaking. Her movements were slow, calculated and lethargic. I could smell a faint odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. She wore heavy perfume which masked the alcoholic beverage smell. She was wearing a tight black dress with black flip flops. I told the driver she was involved in a crash that was captured on video. Moreover the responded deputy observed her sitting in the driver seat of her vehicle after the crash. I explained I was conducting a criminal investigation for DUI. My suspicion was prompted by the previous mentioned indicators of impairment she was exhibiting. Prior to speaking with her further I told her I am required to read her Miranda Warnings in which she acknowledge. I asked if she would consent to an interview. She invoked her "rights". Based on my suspicion I asked if she would consent to performing Standardized Field Sobriety Evaluations (SFSTs) for the purpose of determining if she was impaired while operating a motor vehicle. She refused. I explained Taylor Warning informing the defendant that the SFSTS were voluntary and she did not have to perform them, however in the absence of her performance I would be only left with the physical evidence of impairment before me which could be strong basis for being placed under arrest for DUI. She acknowledged the warnings and eventually agreed to perform the tasks. Prior to her performance I asked if she had any physical problems with her body that would inhibit her from performing light physical exercises. I also asked if she was taking medication. She replied with not having anything wrong with her physically, nor was she taking medication. I escorted her to a level surface that was smooth and free from obstructions and debris. I directed her attention to a white line on the pavement. She acknowledge the line by attempting to place her left foot on it when prompt to do so. The following SFSTs were explained, demonstrated and acknowledged by her prior to her performance: HGN, The Walk and Turn, The One Leg Stand, The Finger to Nose and The Romberg Alphabet Recitation. 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At the conclusion of the SFSTs, coupled with the Deputy's observation of the defendant seated in the driver seat of her vehicle after the crash, the video evidence that showed the defendant's vehicle in motion during the crash and my observation of personal indicators of impairment exhibited by the defendant, probable cause was established for DUI. I told the defendant she was being placed under lawful arrest for DUI. I did a cursory search of her outer clothing and secured her in handcuffs (double locked and checked for tightness) prior to being seated into the rear of my patrol car. I began transport to the main jail breath analysis facility for further processing. Upon our arrival I escorted the defendant into the facility and began a 20 minute observation period. During this time the defendant did not ingest anything into her body orally or otherwise. Neither did she regurgitate. I escorted her into the testing room and asked her to provide breath samples for the purpose of determining his alcohol content. She refused. I read her implied consent and allowed her to read the content herself. Afterward she acknowledged the consent. I asked if she would reconsider and provide breath samples. She refused. At this time she was deemed a "refusal". The defendant invoked her "rights" on scene thus no Q&A was performed. The defendant was cited in the crash for careless driving and booked into the main jail for DUI.

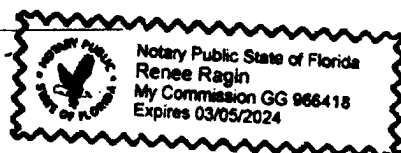

Other Observations:

Subject was asked to stand with their feet together and place their hands by their side. They were asked to focus on the stimulus and follow it with their eyes. Lastly they were told not to move their head to assist in following the stimulus with their eyes. Subject showed equal pupil size that tracked equally. Both eyes lacked a smooth pursuit. I saw distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation. I also saw an onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Subject swayed while performing this task.

WALK & TURN:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE WALK AND TURN. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Subject was unable to maintain her balance while placed in the instructional position. She lost her balance and abandoned the position altogether. During the task she failed to touch heel to toe, she stepped off the line, raised her arms for balance, asked for additional instructions and did not complete the task on her first attempt. The task was re-explained and acknowledged by her a second time. During her second attempt she failed to touch heel toe, she stepped off the line, she took an incorrect number of steps, she turned improperly and could not maintain her balance while walking

ONE LEG STAND:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE ONE LEG STAND. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Subject was unable to maintain her balance while her leg/foot was elevated. She dropped her foot on the pavement three(3) times. She did not look down at her elevated foot as instructed.

FINGER TO NOSE:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE FINGER TO NOSE. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Subject swayed while performing this task, she failed to touch the tip of her finger to the tip of her nose on all six attempts, rather she touched the sides of her nostrils. She also failed to return her arms to her side after making contact with her facial area.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

THE DEFENDANT WAS PLACED IN THE INSTRUCTIONAL STANCE FOR THE ROMBERG ALPHABET TASK. THIS TASK WAS EXPLAINED AND DEMONSTRATED TO THE DEFENDANT. THE DEFENDANT ACKNOWLEDGED THE INSTRUCTIONS PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS TASK: Subject swayed while performing this task, but recited the alphabet correctly

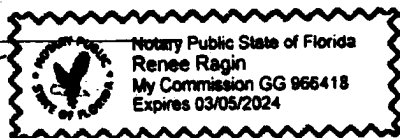
