	On Friday, February 25th, 2022 at approximately 0311 hrs while on routine patrol in the area of US HWY 441 and Boynton Beach Blvd, in unincorporated Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, 33435 I observed a blue Jeep Renegade bearing Florida License Plate 12AYYH stopped in the south bound number one lane of travel at the intersection of US HWY 441 and Boynton Beach Blvd I observed the traffic signal to be green however the vehicle did not proceed through the intersection it remained stationary. I observed that the brake lights were activated indicating the drivers foot was on the brake, I notice that all traffic in the area had proceeded through the intersection and left the area with the exception of the Jeep Renegade. I repositioned my marked patrol vehicle behind the Jeep Renegade and activated my overhead red and blue lights, I noted there was no movement inside of the vehicle at this time. I approached the vehicle on the drivers side, I observed the sole occupant of the vehicle slumped over to her right passed out. I knocked on the window several times and for several minutes before the driver opened her eyes and looked at me, she appeared confused, I yelled several times to her to roll down the windows after several minutes she lowered the left rear passenger window and just stared at me. I then instructed the driver to lower the front drivers window, which she did after several minutes. I instructed the driver to put the vehicle in park to which she stated "Okay" she repeatedly stated "okay" as I told her to put the vehicle in park and shut the engine off. The driver put the vehicle in reverse, I again instructed her to put it in park and she again stated "Okay". While speaking with the driver I notice and extremely strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from her head and shoulder area, I observed her eyes to be red and watery. Based on my observations I believed the driver was operating her motor vehicle under the influence of an unknown alcoholic beverage.

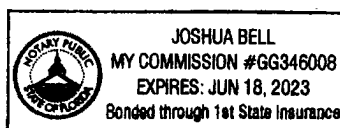

On the finger to nose task Alexis performed as follows she touched her left finger tip to the tip of her nose and raised her left foot up off the ground, she then took one step forward, she then touched her right finger tip to the right side of her nose while raising her right foot off the ground, she next touch her left finger to tip to the tip of her nose while again raising her left leg off the ground, and finally she touched the right tip of her finger to the right side of her nose while again raising her right foot off the ground.

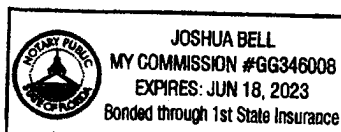
