D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

I was dispatched to a vehicle crash near the intersection of High Ridge Rd and Hypoluxo Rd, Lake Worth FL, in unincorporated Palm Beach County. The crash was called in by a Boynton Beach Police Officer who had arrived on scene moments after the collision. When I arrived on scene I observed two vehicles in the northbound lane of High Ridge Rd, just south of Hypoluxo Rd. There was a blue Ford Explorer (FL Tag #325PGE) with the rear of the vehicle partially on top of the hood of a dark colored Mercedes (FL Tag LMYF33). I observed a white female, later identified as Amanda Rae Alvarado via her Florida DL, sitting behind the wheel of the blue Ford. No other occupants appeared to be in the vehicle. I also observed three black males standing next to the Mercedes. I spoke to the driver and occupants of the Mercedes who identified the white female as the driver and sole occupant of the Ford at the time of the collision. Jean Fortilus pointed out the female driver and also provided a sworn witness statement while on scene.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

During the crash investigation, both parties confirmed that Ms. Alvarado had inadvertently reversed her vehicle into the front of Mr. Fortilus' car. During my interaction with Ms. Alvarado I could smell the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath/mouth. She was slurring her words heavily, her eyes were very bloodshot/ watery and her eyelids were droopy. Her mannerisms were lethargic and labored. She mumbled and repeated herself several times. When she stepped out of the vehicle, I observed that she was unsteady on her feet and staggered to regain her balance. Due to the above referenced indicators of impairment, a DUI investigation was subsequently conducted. I notified Ms. Alvarado that my crash investigation was complete and that I was then conducting a criminal investigation for DUI. She was also read her Miranda Rights after "changing hats" to the criminal investigation. Ms. Alvarado acknowledged that she understood and confirmed that she would attempt the field sobriety exercises. The area where the exercises were conducted was level, clear of debris, and had a clearly marked white parking space line. Prior to beginning the exercises Ms. Alvarado was asked if she was diabetic or had any other medical problems. She confirmed that she was not diabetic, but that she had anxiety, borderline personality disorder, and was on medication for the other mental health issues. She stated that she had not taken any of the medication prior to drinking.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Ms. Alvarado also made a post-miranda confession that she had been driving at the time of the collision. She made the spontaneous utterance that she couldn't do the walk & turn exercise even if she was "sober." Admitted to drinking at the Brass Tap with her friend.

ODORS:

Strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her mouth/breath.

GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

SPEECH: Mumbled, Slurred

ATTITUDE: Polite

CLOTHING: Blue jeans, white shirt, tan shoes (removed during exercises)

MEDICAL/OTHER: [REDACTED] No physical ailments claimed at the time of the exercises. Later said her ankle had been hurt when she was 16 and that her knees hurt (no specific injury or condition).

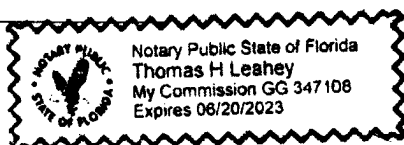

Other Observations:

During the course of the exercise I also observed that she had a difficult time following instructions. She repeatedly moved her head or would stop looking at the light and had to be reminded during the exercise. She also exhibited a sway as she stood in front of me.

WALK & TURN:

The next exercise Ms. Alvarado attempted to perform was the Walk & Turn. I explained and demonstrated the exercise to Ms. Alvarado. She made the spontaneous utterance that she couldn't even do this if she was "sober." While explaining and demonstrating the exercise, she had a very difficult time maintaining her balance. She stepped off the line several times and had to regain her balance/composure. Once Ms. Alvarado acknowledged that she understood and had no questions, she attempted the exercise. During the exercise attempt(s) I observed the following clues of impairment: unable to balance while listening to instructions; stepped off the line; did not touch heel-to-toe; she took the incorrect number of steps; improperly performed the turnaround; and used her arms for balance. Ms. Alvarado appeared very unsteady and unbalanced throughout the exercise.

ONE LEG STAND:

Ms. Alvarado was then asked to perform the One Leg Stand exercise. I demonstrated and explained the exercise until she confirmed that she understood and had no questions. During her attempt at this exercise I observed the following clues of impairment: raised arms for balance; put her foot down several times; and swayed. Ms. Alvarado was unable to hold her foot up for anything more than 5-6 seconds at a time. She also didn't count in the manner described and nearly fell over while attempting. She made several attempts, but exhibited the above referenced indicators each time.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I then asked Ms. Alvarado to perform the Finger-To-Nose Exercise. The exercise was demonstrated and explained to Ms. Alvarado who acknowledged that she understood. During this exercise I observed that she would partially open her eyes; she missed touching the tip of her finger to the tip of her nose on a few of attempts; she swayed while standing; and she had to be reminded to remove her finger front her nose.

MODIFIED ROMBERG:

The last exercise I asked Ms. Alvarado to perform was the Modified Rhomberg exercise. For this exercise Ms. Alvarado was asked to tilt her head back, close her eyes, and estimate the passage of 30 seconds in her head (not out loud). Once 30 seconds had elapsed, to lean her head forward, open her eyes, and say stop to end the exercise. She verified she understood and had no questions. Once the exercise began, approximately 1:14 seconds elapsed and she had not yet indicated to stop. When I questioned her, she said that: 56 seconds had elapsed. It appeared that she had a difficult time following the instructions that had just been explained.

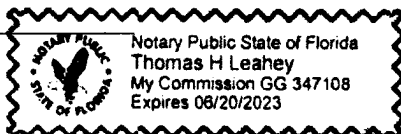
