Probable Cause

On the above date and time, I, Trooper J. Lampiasi ID1716, was traveling northbound on SR-7 just north of SR-806 in Palm Beach County, Florida. I observed a dark Nissan SUV bearing FL Tag IW97GG weaving within its lane of

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travel. The vehicle was currently in the right outside lane. The vehicle was touching both lane lines, straddling the shoulder, and driving onto the shoulder on an occasion. Due to the fact that the driver may be having a medical emergency, I initiated a traffic stop. The driver was slow to respond to my emergency lights, however, managed to pull over to the right shoulder after some time.

I approached the driver side window and made contact with the driver, identified via her FL DL as Amy J. Rohan. Ms. Rohan appeared to have a confused and dazed facial expression. I immediately smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from within the vehicle. Ms. Rohan's eyes were watery and glassy. I asked Ms. Rohan if she was okay and observed that she was. As Ms. Rohan spoke, I smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath. Ms. Rohan stated that she might be a little intoxicated after asking if she had anything to drink. Ms. Rohan stated she had two (2) glasses of wine in Boca Raton while on a date. Ms. Rohan stated she was a light weight and might have had too much. At that time, I ran Ms. Rohan via FCIC/NCIC which resulted in a valid FL DL.

I approached the driver side window once again. Ms. Rohan asked if I would be able to follow her home to her residence, which I advised I could not. I requested Ms. Rohan to participate in Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFST's), which she agreed. Ms. Rohan stepped out of the vehicle and appeared uneasy at first. Ms. Rohan appeared to be unbalanced while standing still.

Each task was explained and demonstrated to Ms. Rohan and I confirmed that she understood each one prior to beginning the tasks.

The first task given was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) task. I confirmed that her pupils were of equal size. I observed no resting nystagmus and her eyes were tracking equally. While having her follow the stimulus, I observed a total of 6 clues (lack of smooth pursuit in the left eye, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in the left eye, onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in the left eye, lack of smooth pursuit in the right eye, distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in the right eye, onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in the right eye). I checked for and observed a vertical nystagmus. During the task,

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Ms. Rohan was swaying her body visibly. I had to remind Ms. Rohan to keep her head straight multiple times as well as how to properly stand. Ms. Rohan failed to follow the stimulus at times and kept staring straight ahead. Even after advising Ms. Rohan to follow the stimulus and keep her head straight, she continued to move her head.

The next task requested was the 9 Step Walk and Turn. Ms. Rohan had a very difficult time trying to stand properly on the marked white lane. Even after multiple attempts to try and demonstrate the task to Ms. Rohan, she could not stand properly. Ms. Rohan kept saying she was cold. Ms. Rohan would not participate in any of the tasks as she would not cooperate and could not stand on the line properly.

Due to the totality of the circumstances regarding Ms. Rohan's driving behavior, personal interaction, and SFST performance, I concluded that Ms. Rohan's normal faculties were impaired at the time she operated the motor vehicle. Ms. Rohan was arrested for Driving Under the Influence at 2346 hours. Ms. Rohan was handcuffed (double locked) and placed in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

Ms. Rohan was transported to the Palm Beach County Jail. I observed Ms. Rohan for twenty minutes (20) beginning at 0036 hours. During that time, I had constant visual observation on Ms. Rohan and confirmed that she did not regurgitate or ingest any object or substance. I requested Ms. Rohan to provide a sample of her breath, which she agreed. Ms. Rohan's breath samples were as follows: 0.145/0.152. Ms. Rohan agreed to answer interview questions after being read Miranda at 0107 hours. Ms. Rohan was transferred into the custody of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office for booking.

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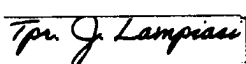
