The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On 12/13/2020, at approximately 0038 hours, at Providence Rd. / Causeway Bl., Brandon, FL 33510, I conducted a traffic stop on a gray Hyundai (bearing FL tag IMXC50 / VIN: 5NPEB4AC8CH406728) for inoperable tag lights (FSS 316.610) and after observing the vehicle come to an abrupt stop in its lane, travel across all lanes and weaving within its lane. Upon making contact, the defendant was observed to have glassy, watery eyes, slurred speech, and I detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from her breath. She also struggled locating the requested documentation (vehicle registration / current proof of insurance). Post Miranda, the defendant admitted to coming from a bar in Valrico and consuming approximately 2 beers. The defendant was given the opportunity to perform field sobriety exercises, which she did poorly indicating impairment. Subsequent to arrest, the defendant provided breath samples of .170/.182 after a twenty minute observation period. The defendant was identified via their Florida driver's license.
