(Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)</p> <p>On 05/29/2020 while on patrol in the Brickyard parking lot (7050 Palmetto Park Rd, unincorporated Boca Raton FL 33433) I observed 4 individuals enter a 4 door dark gray Acura (FL Tag#: LFXD05). The vehicle was parked facing east in the 2nd row in front of Brickyards doors. The occupants remained in the vehicle for approximately 5 minutes, at which time three occupants exited the vehicle and the driver remained in the driver seat. I watched the driver, Hispanic female (later identified via FL DL as Andrea Haemmerle), sit in the car for several more minutes while I was concealed directly in front of her vehicle, out of her sight.</p> <p>The driver appeared extremely disoriented and intoxicated, her head was nodding back and forth, her eyes were closed, and she was mumbling unknown words to herself in the vehicle. The female was in this condition for several minutes. I then observed her holding a clear plastic bag of green rectangular pills which she seemed to shove into the pocket of the driver door. I immediately recognized the pills to be alprazolam/"Xanax" due to their distinct green color and distinct rectangular "bar" shape. It is not common for prescription holders to keep a large amount of Alprazolam in a clear plastic bag, as they are required to remain in the prescription bottle.</p> <p>The female then exited the vehicle and walked to a black Volkswagen in the parking lot and entered the Volkswagen with 4 other females. D/S J. Colon made contact with the individuals at the Volkswagen where he discovered that one of the females, Kasey Davis, were in possession of cocaine (reference D/S Colon's case #: 20072865).</p> <p>While D/S Colon spoke to the individuals at the Volkswagen, including Andrea, I took a closer look through the passenger side window of the Acura and observed the same pills wrapped up in a clear bag sticking out of the interior door pocket. The bag and pills were the same that I saw in I could immediately tell that they were the same Alprazolam seen in Andrea's hand.</p> <p>I then detained Andrea in handcuffs behind her back (checked for proper fit and double locked) and took her Acura key from her. I opened the door of her vehicle and confirmed that the pills I saw in her possession were alprazolam. There were 8.5 pills which were marked "S903" (identified via drugs.com as Alprazolam 2mg SCHD 4).</p> <p>I read Andrea her Miranda Rights via a prepared text. Andrea stated that she understood her rights and would speak with me. I told Andrea that I observed her in her vehicle for several minutes, that she appeared intoxicated, and I asked her if she was doing drugs in the car. Andrea mumbled that she, "did the same drugs as the other girls" but would not expound further. I informed Andrea that I found Alprazolam in her door and saw her in possession of it. Andrea claimed full ownership of the Alprazolam, she initially stated that she has a prescription for it but then retracted that statement and stated that she really got the alprazolam from her sister. Andrea stated that she is not prescribed Alprazolam but should be because it helps her with her social anxiety.</p> <p>I find probable cause to charge Andrea with possession of a controlled substance (schedule 4) in violation of F.S.S. 893.13(6)(a). Andrea was then transported to PBSO Maia Jail without incident.</p>
