

<p>On 01-08-21, I was assigned to a theft case where the victim dropped her purse outside of Publix Supermarket, located at 4060 South US Highway 1, Jupiter FL 33477 on 01-06-21 at approximately 1800 hours. The Louis Vuitton purse valued at \$1,000.00 contained \$600.00 cash, car keys valued at \$300.00 and miscellaneous cards to include Costco card, medical insurance card, Saks 5th Avenue card, and a gift card of unknown value. The initial report notes that video surveillance is available of the incident, where a subject retrieves the victim's wallet from the ground, in front of Publix.</p>											
<p>On 01-08-21, I spoke to Publix Supermarket Manager Dan Duane. Duane provided a Florida vehicle license plate believed to be the person who picked up the victim's lost wallet in the Publix Supermarket parking lot. I later ran the Florida license plate (PCR N17) and found that it was registered to Andrew Lawrence Blumstein 11-06-1963, who resides at 3224 32nd Court, Jupiter, FL 33477. FL license plate PCR N17 is assigned to a red colored Jeep utility style automobile. Manager Dan Duane obtained this license plate from recognizing a frequent customer from the surveillance video and obtained the license plate in the Publix parking lot.</p>											
<p>On 01-14-21 at approximately 0930 hours, I went to 3224 32nd Court Jupiter FL 33477 in reference to following up on the investigative lead provided to me by the Publix Supermarket manager. I was accompanied by Detective Danielle Hirsch. The Jeep vehicle bearing FL license plate PCR N17 was found to be parking in the townhomes' parking lot area. I knocked on the outer wooden gate of Blumstein's townhome residence. Blumstein came to the outer wooden fence gate and opened it. I identified myself and provided Blumstein with my business card. The following is a summary, which is not verbatim</p>											
<p>I explained to Blumstein that the reason why I came to his residence is because on the sixth of February, I believe that he found a purse at the Publix plaza. Blumstein replied, yeah, I don't have it. I asked Blumstien if he had it and he replied, it was</p>

on the floor, on the parking lot. Blumstein then stated, what am I gonna do and asked if he was in trouble. I explained to Blumstein that when you find something you are supposed to turn it in to the police. Blumstein stated, It was on the floor in the middle of nowhere, there was nothing in it, then stated that there was money in it.



I explained to Blumstein that the lady's purse had a lot of sentimental value and she'd like to get it back. I asked if he knew where it might be and he replied that he got rid of it, he threw it out. Blumstein advised that he took the money and threw the purse out. I asked Blumstein if there was anywhere I could go and find the purse, Blumstein replied that he threw it out.

I further explained to Blumstein that by law when you find something of value in a public area you have to turn it in to the police. I explained to Blumstein that I was hoping that he had the purse. I told Blumstein that I was going to follow back up with the victim and tell her the purse is gone. I asked Blumstein if the purse is in a trash can. Blumstein advised that he tossed it out and now it's in the dump.

I then asked Blumstein if he wished to give me an official statement on what happened, I stated that it was up to him. Blumstein then began to explain that it was on the floor of the parking lot by Publix and I picked it up, I thought it was finder keepers. I told Blumstein that the victim made a report and wanted something done about it and I stated that technically it is theft. Blumstein told me that he didn't know it was theft. Blumstein advised that ethically it's not the right thing to do. Blumstein asked if he was in trouble and I told him that he can be. I told Blumstein that I was going to follow up with the victim and see what she wants to do. Blumstein stated, want me to pay her back. I told Blumstein that I could ask her that.

I told Blumstein that her main thing was the purse. I explained to Blumstein that her husband bought it for her before he passed away and it was a big thing to her. I told Blumstein that I was going to follow back up with the victim and we'll go from there. I inquired with Blumstein if he wanted me to ask the victim if she wished to accept payment for it, because he previously mentioned that. Blumstein stated, see what she wants to do. At this point I was about to depart and Blumstein asked if I wanted his telephone number and he provided it to me (917-567-0996). Blumstein then asked me, how did it get back to me. I explained that we back tracked with the video at the Publix counter, which back tracked to his car. I explained to Blumstein that I wasn't exactly sure if it was going to be him. Blumstein then asked me if the most important thing to the victim was the purse. I told Blumstein that the cash was important and that I'll follow back up with her.

Detective Hirsch reiterated that the Purse was a gift from her husband that died. Blumstein then stated, what if I have the purse. I then stated, its pretty important to her because it came from her late husband. Blumstein stated, I gave it to my
