On the <u>28</u> day of <u>August</u>, <u>2020</u> at <u>00:51</u> (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest) On 8/28/2020, at approximately 2318 hours, I responded to 601 W Camino Real as a back-up unit for a single vehicle crash. Upon arrival, I observed a gray Jeep Cherokee, bearing FL tag NTKXN87, with extensive front end damage and deployed airbags up against a flag pole on the front lawn of the residence. I also observed the vehicle's motor was in the middle of the roadway on SW 6th Ave, what appeared to be a powerline lying across W Camino Real, a heavily damaged cement light post, and uprooted vegetation. A W/M subject on scene with minor abrasions on his right wrist/forearm claimed to be the driver, and sole occupant, of the vehicle at the time of the crash. The subject identified himself as Anisim Miljutin by NY DL. It should be noted that the vehicle was registered to Miljutin and the resident at 598 SW 6th Ave, James Perry, reported seeing Miljutin step out of the vehicle from the front driver door prior to BRPD arrival. Perry provided a sworn witness statement. When I made contact with Miljutin I observed that his eyes were glassy and red. As time passed, I noticed that he had a strong odor of alcohol emanating from his person, was very talkative, had difficulty following simple instructions, and asked the same questions repeatedly. Miljutin also referred to the crash as "minor" on several occasions despite breaking a light post into numerous pieces and causing the vehicle's motor to separate from the body. Once Officer Hettchen completed his crash investigation he informed Miljutin that the crash investigation was complete and that I had additional questions to ask. I then informed Miljutin that I would be conducting a criminal DUI investigation based on the nature of the crash and my observations suggesting that she may have been driving impaired at the time of the crash. I advised Miljutin of his constitutional warnings and he stated that he understood. I asked Miljutin where he was coming from and he advised he was on his way home from

Biergarten which is a restaurant/bar in downtown Boca Raton. Miljutin claimed he did not consume any alcoholic beverages and stated he was willing to submit to Standardized Field Sobriety Exercises. I asked Miljutin a series of questions prior to beginning the exercises. I asked him if he was sick or injured and he stated he was not. He did not complain of any physical injuries other than minor abrasions on his right forearm/wrist and an abrasion on his left shin. According to Miljutin, the abrasions did not affect his ability to walk, stand, or balance. I asked Miljutin if he was taking a prescription medication and he informed me he was not. He also stated he was no diabetic. Lastly, I asked Miljutin if he felt comfortable walking in the shoes he was wearing and he said he did. I then proceeded with the exercises. The first exercise was Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I administered the instructions and Miljutin stated that he understood. Miljutin moved his head when following despite being instructed not to do so. I also observed that Miljutin was swaying in a circular motion while the exercise was being conducted. The second exercise was the Walk and Turn. I administered the instructions and demonstrated how the exercise should be completed. Miljutin stated that he understood all of my instructions and was instructed to begin the exercise. I noticed that Miljutin had some difficulty getting into the starting position. He also took 10 steps on the first set of steps, made an improper turn, and took 11 steps on the second set of steps. The third exercise was the One-Leg Stand. I administered the instructions and demonstrated how it should be completed. Miljutin stated he understood. Miljutin hopped and swayed in a circular motion was completing the exercise. The fourth exercise was the Finger to Nose. I confirmed that Miljutin knew his left from hers right by asking him to show me his left hand and then his right hand. I then administered the instructions. The pattern was L-R-L-R-R-L. L - Missed the tip of his nose. R - Missed the tip of his nose. L - Missed the tip of his nose. R - Missed the tip of his nose. R - Missed the tip of his nose. L - No clues observed. The fifth exercise was the modified romberg balance test. I asked Miljutin if he felt comfortable estimating the passage of 30 seconds and he stated yes. I demonstrated the passage of 30 seconds using a stop watch. The instructions were administered, and the exercise was conducted. Miljutin estimated the passage of 30 seconds in 37 seconds. He also swayed in a circular motion was completing the exercise. The sixth exercise was a counting exercise. I asked Miljutin if he knew how to count to

100 and he stated he did. I administered the instructions and asked Miljutin to count from 32 to 57. Miljutin started counting from 33 and only said "five, six, seven" when counting the last few numbers. The final exercise was the Romberg Alphabet. I asked Miljutin if he knew English alphabet, and he advised that he did. I administered the instructions and Miljutin stated he understood. Miljutin completed the exercise properly. At the conclusion of the exercises Miljutin confessed to consuming one beer prior to driving. Based on the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to believe that, at the time of the crash, Miljutin was operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of drugs or alcohol. Miljutin was placed under arrest for DUI per F.S.S 316.193(3C1). He was transported to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office DUI Testing Facility where Breath Operator S. O'neal (#6212) completed the BAT room procedures. Miljutin provided two breath samples of .148 and .149. He was advised of his constitutional warnings, stated he understood, and chose to answer all of my questions. His answers were documented on the DUI influence report. See Officer Hettchens's crash report (HSVM #200496547) for more information regarding the crash and the property damage associated.
