

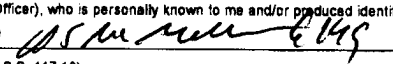

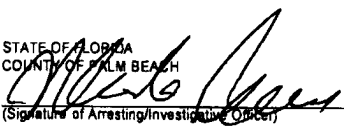

VICTIM #2: Kaityln Tucciarone 09/14/1997 VICTIM #3: Amber Cavazos 01/03/1994 On 03/14/2021 at about 2045 hours, I responded to 1005 N SR7 (PAPICHULO'S) , located in the Village of Royal Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida in reference to a disturbance. Upon arrival, I met with the caller/manager of Papichulo's, Ryan Chrisley who advised several patrons in the restaurant were causing a disturbance and were refusing to leave. He also received several complaints from his staff that they were assaulted/battered by these same patrons. He later advised several individuals in the large group of patrons appeared to be intoxicated as they arrived. I first met with victim #2, Kaitlyn Tucciarone, who advised she was sitting down at the bar with other co-workers (while working) when the group of patrons walked inside from the outside sitting area, screaming and yelling profanities at the staff. Tucciarone advised defendant #1, Maria Serrano, walked up to her and shoved her with both hands, pushing her against the bar. She advised Serrano yelled at her to "hit me bitch" and continued to lunge at her after the initial contact was made. Several of her co-workers needed to restrain Serrano from continuing forward towards her for a further attack. Serrano and the group of people she was with, including defendant #2, Anthony Genovese, whom both continued to yell and scream obscenities at the staff, causing numerous other patrons to get up and leave without finishing their meals. Management advised they had to apologize to multiple patrons as they left due to the disturbance that occurred and was caused by both subjects. Tucciarone also explained that during the encounter, Genovese began to approach her aggressively and was held back by other patrons, while he lifted his arms up as if trying to get to her to attack her. This behavior placed her in fear that another attack, this time by Genovese, was imminent towards her. I then met with victim #3, Amber Cavazos, who advised she was sitting next to Tucciarone at the bar when the group of patrons walked inside from the outside sitting area, screaming and yelling profanities at the staff. She advised that defendant #1, Maria Serrano, walked up to Tucciarone and shoved her with both hands, causing Tucciarone to be shoved against the bar. Serrano then shoved her [Cavazos] with her right hand, causing her sweater to fall off her left shoulder. She advised that Serrano continued to yell and scream profanities at her and her staff, while still trying to lunge forward at her while being restrained by other co-workers. This behavior led her to believe that a further attack was imminent against both her and Tucciarone. Additionally, she observed defendant #2, Genovese, screaming profanities at them, while being held back by co-workers, preventing him from attacking she and Tucciarone.

I then met with Witness #1, Trinity Sitterson, who advised she was by the North entrance to the restaurant when she was approached by a patron who told her they were sorry for her having to deal with customers like that. She was not aware of what they were talking about so she walked inside and saw the commotion. She observed Serrano yelling and screaming obscenities as she was being escorted out of the business by the manager and other co-workers. She advised that she observed several other patrons get up and ask for their tabs so they could leave due to the disturbance. She was lastly approached by another patron who told her they doubt they would ever return to this restaurant because of this disturbance. Additionally, she stated that she witnessed Serrano shove both victims while Genovese was held back from trying to attack both victims. She also witnessed both shouting profanities at staff and was fearful it would escalate further. I then met with witness #2, Amber Satriano, who advised she witnessed the commotion and saw several customers leave the establishment because of the disturbance. She also witnessed Genovese commit a battery against victim #1, her manager, Jean Pierre Bowles. She stated that prior to the altercation in the restaurant, Bowles was holding a tray of food, when Genovese slammed a plate down, violently, on the tray that Bowles was holding, nearly causing him to drop the tray and move him backwards. She further witnessed Serrano enter the restaurant and shove her co-worker, Tucciarone, against the bar. She also saw Genovese being held back by patrons as if he was trying to attack both Tucciarone and Cavazos. She also witnessed the ongoing verbal onslaught of profanities and vulgarities from both Genovese and Cavazos to the point that customers began to leave the restaurant. I then met with witness #3, Ava Visoke, who advised she witnessed the commotion and saw several customers leave the establishment because of the disturbance. Additionally, she observed the initial battery take place when Genovese slammed the plate down on the tray that her manager, Bowles, was holding. She explained that the act was with such force that it almost caused Bowles to lose balance as a result. I then met with witness #, Caroline Edwards, who advised she witnessed the defendant strike Tucciarone and heard her yelling "you're a whore and and should work in a strip club and suck a dick." She witnessed the entire group the defendant was with, cause a disturbance by yelling and screaming which then caused multiple patrons leave the restaurant. Additionally, she witnessed Serrano push her co-worker, Tucciarone, against the bar while saying "hit me bitch." She believes many of the customers left after being frightened by the disturbance.

I then met with witness #5, Alexa Benusi, who advised she remembered the large group of patrons that first walked in with the defendants, requesting to be seated. She advised they appeared to be intoxicated prior to arriving at the establishment. She advised they made a large order of alcoholic beverages while they were at the establishment, further corroborating both defendants' intoxication during the incident. She described the behavior of both defendants as aggressive and violent. While conducting my initial investigation, the defendants advised they received bad service and only wanted to pay their bill and leave the restaurant. Both defendants denied causing a disturbance and striking anyone. Both defendants initially stated that they were the ones who were assaulted/battered by the staff and demanded that we check the surveillance footage. It should be noted that while speaking with the defendants, I could smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from their body and breath. I also saw that both had red glassy eyes and slurred speech. Finally, I reviewed the surveillance footage, which corroborated that Serrano shoved Tucciarone, then also struck Cavazos. Additionally, it was clearly observed that Genovese had been aggressively attempting to get to both Tucciarone and Cavazos as they were cornered at the bar. An unknown male in a white shirt was scene holding Genovese back, while Genovese is seen lifting his arms up and trying to advance towards the two female victims. It was also corroborated that no staff members attacked the defendants and that both defendants did not act in self-defense. Based on the above facts, Maria Serrano did commit two (2) counts of Battery F.S.S. 784.03(1A1), by knowingly and willfully touching/striking Tucciarone and Cavazos, by shoving both of them against the bar, without their consent, pursuant to FSS 784.03(1)(a)(1) Both defendants, Serrano and Geonyese did commit Two (2) counts of Assault each, by knowingly and willfully aggressively moving towards both of the victims after the initial attack, having to be pulled back by other patrons/staff, causing both victims to fear that an attack was imminent, pursuant to FSS 784.011 Disorderly Intoxication, by knowingly and willfully causing a public disturbance upon the premises of an establishment, while intoxicated by alcoholic beverage(s), pursuant to FSS 856.011 Disorderly Conduct, by knowingly and willfully causing a public disturbance through screaming profanities and brawling within the premises of an establishment, causing a noticeable reaction of patrons leaving, pursuant to FSS 877.03
