On the above date at approximately 0354 hours I was on routine patrol in the area of West Indiantown Road and Military Trail in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, Florida.

I had just finished backing up another officer one block to the east. I observed a vehicle quickly approaching in my rear view mirror. This is a posted 45 mile per hour zone. I visually estimated the vehicle's speed at 60 miles per hour. I activated my car Stalker Dual SL radar (sn DD005051) in same direction moving mode (rear facing antenna). The patrol speed matched my vehicle's certified speedometer. The target speed indicated a speed of 60 miles per hour. I heard a clear audio Doppler tone. I waited for the vehicle to pass me, which it did just east of Pennock Lane. As it approached my vehicle it slowed down significantly. I allowed the vehicle to pass. I observed the vehicle swerving within its lane, though this did not affect other traffic. As the vehicle passed my car, it sped up to a radar confirmed speed of 53 miles per hour. I caught up to the vehicle in the area of Palm Avenue and initiated a traffic stop of the vehicle as it turned into the Jupiter West Plaza.

I walked up to the driver's side door and spoke to the driver, Ashley Evans. I could immediately smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle and later found to be on Evans' breath. Evans had bloodshot and glassy eyes. Evans' speech was slurred. Evans stated she'd consumed one beer only. Upon the arrival of Officer Matonti, who was acting as my back up officer, I selected a nearby area to conduct roadside tasks. I asked Evans to exit her vehicle. Evans did so. I asked Evans how sober she felt on a scale of 1-10. Evans stated she was a "three." I asked Evans to complete roadside tasks. Evans agreed.

I first conducted Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. I am a certified Drug Recognition Expert and completed the task in a manner consistent with my training. I observed lack of

Evans appeared to become impatient and annoyed during the task and I had to remind her more than once to keep her head still during the task.



I then conducted the Walk and Turn task. I asked Evans if she wanted to take off her shoes. Evans did and stumbled back as she slipped them off. During the task, Evans lost her balance from the starting position twice and started early twice. Evans missed heel to toe on every step except the fifth. Evans used her arms for balance. Evans took only eight steps and stopped. Evans completely forgot to turn around or return back down the line.

I then started the One Leg Stand task. Evans stated she has poor balance and couldn't do the task. Evans then stated she has Fibromyalgia and it affects "everything" and used that as an excuse for having poor balance and being unable to complete the task. I asked Evans if she would be more comfortable completing the seated battery of tasks and she said she would. I retrieved a folding chair for that purpose from my vehicle.

I next conducted the Seated Finger to Nose task. During the instructions, Evans closed her eyes. I had to ask Evans several times to open her eyes so she could understand the instructions. I had to remind Evans to tilt her head back when I said "begin." L1: Evans touched her nose over her left nostril before moving it to the tip of her nose. Evans did not return her hand to the side. I reminded her to. R2: Evans touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. R2: Evans touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. L3: Evans touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. R4: Evans touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. R5: Evans started to use the wrong hand, changed to the right hand and touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger. L6: Evans touched the tip of her nose with the pad of her finger.

I then conducted the Palm Pat task. Evans patted her hands four times before stopping and staring at me. I reminded her of the instructions. Evans then started patting her palms but did not count and did not speed up. Evans did not make a serious attempt to properly follow the instructions and appeared bored and disinterested during the task.

I started the Hand Coordination task. Evans stated she would be unable to complete the task due to "ADD." I decided not to continue with the tasks as Evans was obviously impaired. I had Evans stand up and placed Evans under arrest for DUI. I secured Evans in handcuffs which I checked for spacing and double locked. I transported Evans to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing Center. I conducted a 20 minute observation period. I then requested Evans provide a sample of her breath. Evans refused. I read Implied Consent from a prepared text. Evans stated she understood it and again refused to provide a sample of her breath. I then read Evans her Miranda Rights from a prepared

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


This was due to the appearance of a friend (a former Jupiter Police Officer) whom she called to the scene in spite of the fact I directed Evans several times to not use the phone. I later uploaded my dash camera to evidence.com for future use in this case.

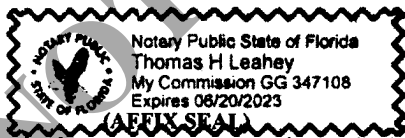
