The undersigned swears that he/she has reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant on the 29 day of FEBRUARY, 2020,

at approximately 2:08 AM, at 242 1ST AVENUE NORTH, in Pinellas County did:

WAS THEN AND THERE INTOXICATED AND CAUSED A PUBLIC DISTURBANCE, TO-WIT: REFUSING TO LEAVE MACDINTON'S CAUSING SECURITY TO PHYSICALLY REMOVE HIM THEN ARGUING WITH POLICE IN PUBLIC AFTER BEING ORDERED TO LEAVE.

THE DEFENDANT WAS INTOXICATED AS OBSERVED BY HIS BLOODSHOT WATERY EYES, INABILITY TO STAND WITHOUT SWAYING OR LEANING OVER, ODOR OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON HIS BREATH, DILATED PUPILS, AND SLURRED SPEECH. THE DEFENDANT WAS PHYSICALLY REMOVED FROM MACDINTON'S BY HAVING BOTH ARMS RESTRAINED BEHIND HIS BACK AND ESCORTED OFF THE PROPERTY AFTER CAUSING A DISTURBANCE ON THE PROPERTY AND REFUSING TO LEAVE WHEN ORDERED TO DO SO BY SECURITY. THE DEFENDANT THEN REFUSED TO WALK AWAY AFTER BEING ORDERED TO DO SO SEVERAL TIMES BY POLICE AND CAUSED A DISTURBANCE BY ARGUING WITH POLICE AND YELLING "TAKE ME TO JAIL!" WHEN ORDERED TO LEAVE SEVERAL TIMES.



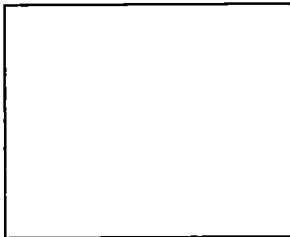
