## NARRATIVE:

In the County of Palm Beach, the following incident occurred:

On July 16<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at approximately 1750 hours, I conducted a traffic stop on a black Saturn Florida Handicap Tag: CVE8 on I-95 just south of Northlake Boulevard, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, within Palm Beach County, for traveling 74 miles per hour in a 65 mile per hour zone. I paced this vehicle as my car is calibrated.

Upon activating my emergency lights and siren, the front driver, and rear passenger who were both females began to move frantically in the vehicle down towards the floorboard of the vehicle, I observed the driver's body twist downward towards the right as if reaching to the floorboard with her right arm. The rear passenger was also making a similar movement reaching down toward the floorboard.

The driver then rolled down the front driver's window and put her arm out the window. I observed a small capsule like object fall from the driver's hand onto the outside lane of I-95.

It should be noted that the vehicle took approximately one mile to stop from the time I initialed my emergency lights and siren.

I made contact with the driver who was identified by Florida License as Jessica Donahue W/F (10/16/1984), front passenger, James Johnson W/M (08/26/1978) and rear passenger Briana Bright W/F (12/31/1997).

## NARRATIVE CONTINUATION

The driver was sweating profusely and when I asked her for her identification and shaking profusely, she could not even hand me the ID as her hands were shaking uncontrollably.

Ms. Donahue advised me that she was scared because she had a warrant for her arrest. Ms. Donahue then advised me she was going to be honest and stated that she had just purchased a heroin cap from a male named James. Ms. Donahue advised me that she had put the heroin cap in her purse and that I could search the vehicle. Ms. Donahue handed me her purse. Ms. Donahue, Mr. Johnson, and Ms. Bright were removed from the vehicle due to the furtive movements and the fact that Ms. Donahue gave verbal consent to search the vehicle. I searched Ms. Donahue's purse and vehicle with negative results of finding a capsule. I did locate five straws in Ms. Donahue's door compartment that she advised she would cut to snort Heroin.

While standing on the side of the vehicle, Ms. Bright reached into her pants and removed a silver in color piece of tinfoil and threw the tinfoil directly in front of me onto the tall grass on the side of I-95. Inside of the tinfoil, was a broken capsule. Ms. Bright then removed a cut straw from her pants as well. From my training and experience I know that drug users use cut straws to ingest the drugs they use. I swabbed the residue on the tinfoil and broken capsule and tested it in a Marquis field test kit. The residue field tested positive for Amphetamine. During the swab, the residue was all used in the field test kit.

Ms. Donahue advised me that she wanted to be honest and advised me that she threw the heroin capsule out of her car when I initiated my traffic stop. I read Ms. Donahue her Miranda Rights on recording and conducted a post Miranda Statement. ( Not Verbatim) Ms. Donahue admitted that she was speeding because she was going around a car on 95. Ms. Donahue advised that she bought the heroin from "James" by Dollar General in a White Jeep with a black top. Ms. Donahue advised that when I conducted the traffic stop she decided to throw the capsule out of the window.



Based on the above information, I Find Probable Cause for the arrest of Ms. Bright for Tampering with Evidence F.S.S. 918.13 by discarding and purposely getting rid of narcotic evidence in the grass, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia F.S.S. 893.147 (1B) for the straw used to ingest the narcotics, and Possession of Amphetamine F.S.S. 893.13(6A) for the residue on the foil and capsule.

I find Probable Cause exists for the arrest of Ms. Donahue for Tampering with Evidence F.S.S. 918.13 for throwing the Heroin capsule out of the vehicle which I had observed and by her own Post Miranda admission when I initiated the traffic stop and

Possession of Drug Paraphernalia F.S.S. 893.147(1B) for the straws in her door compartment.

Ms. Donahue and Ms. Bright were placed under arrest and transported to Palm Beach County Jail for booking purposes.
