The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did
 On July 7, 2020 at approximately 2331 hours, the affiant was operating her unmarked Dodge Charger patrol vehicle headed eastbound on Brandon Boulevard West near the intersection with Hilltop Road South when she observed an ambulance with its emergency lights and sirens activated in the left lane. The affiant along with many other drivers on the roadway changed lanes to the center or far right lane to allow the ambulance to pass. As the ambulance passed, a gray Kia Sportage came traveling at a high rate of speed from behind the affiant to the eastbound lane left of the affiant, passed the affiant, and passed the ambulance. The affiant visually estimated the Kia's speed at 72 miles per hour in a 50 miles per hour zone. The affiant activated her certified and calibrated RADAR in Moving Mode-Same Direction Traffic and heard an audio DOPPLER tone consistent with the screen readout of 71 miles per hour. The affiant conducted a traffic stop of the Kia Sportage bearing Florida tag:433RPD (V.I.N.: KNDPB3A27B7016149) and upon activation of the affiant's vehicle's emergency lights, the Kia pulled over onto the sidewalk (passing a shopping center driveway by several feet). On contact with the driver/defendant, the affiant observed her eyes were bloodshot and glassy and there was a strong and distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath. The affiant asked if the defendant was having a medical emergency and the defendant stated no as well as she "didn't realize I was going that fast." The affiant requested the defendant provide a driver license, proof of vehicle registration, and proof of vehicle insurance. After approximately two minutes of fumbling with cards and paperwork in her wallet, the defendant was unable to provide a driver license. The affiant requested the defendant exit the vehicle and as the affiant spoke with the defendant further, she observed the defendant stand with a sway. The affiant requested the defendant perform field sobriety exercises which she agreed to do. Throughout the performance of the exercises the defendant displayed indicators of impairment and was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence. An inventory search of the Kia Sportage yielded an orange prescription bottle with torn off label containing 14 Adderall XR capsules (as printed on capsule and confirmed as 30 milligram capsules via drugs.com) in the center console arm rest area. Adderall XR is a Schedule II Controlled Substance which requires a prescription. The affiant transported the defendant to Central Breath Testing where after a proper twenty-minute observation period was conducted, the defendant provided two lawful breath samples of .145/.146% B.A.C. respectively. The defendant identified herself verbally and her identity was confirmed via DAVID photograph and Florida Driver License which was located during the inventory search.
