

**Affidavit by United States Military Law Enforcement Officer Pursuant to F.S.S.
901.15(9)**

I, Matthew W. Johnson, do hereby swear or affirm that while in performance of my duties at the Police-1 / Lead Patrol ^{ON} outside of MacDill Air Force Base, which is Federal Military Property, on 14 SEP 2020 at approximately 2330 AM/PM a MERCEDES ES3 BLACK in color, stopped on the base inside the gate. The FL state license plate # PAC A 79 was attached to the vehicle. The operator of the vehicle identified himself/herself as BRYAN DONALD HENK. I asked the driver or passenger(s) for their driver's license or identification. The driver or passenger(s):

- could not produce a drivers license
- produced an I.D. card
- had distinct/strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from their breath
- had an open container of alcohol in plain view
- had a firearm/weapon in plain view
- had suspected controlled substance in plain view
- other (explain below)

Based upon the following observations:

The operator of the vehicle had a distinct odor of alcohol, slurred speech, & bloodshot eyes. Upon having the individual exit the vehicle, I identified that he was having trouble standing on his own & swaying back & forth uncontrollably.

I contacted the Tampa Police Department through the MacDill Air Force Base Dispatch at 2337 AM/PM and requested their assistance with the above named person(s).
