The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did

On March 7, 2020 at approximately 0224 hours, Deputy J. Ream (ABN:25326) was operating his fully-marked patrol vehicle headed southbound on Parsons Avenue South near the intersection of Brandon Boulevard East when he observed a gray Chevrolet Silverado bearing Florida tag:311TUS(V.I.N.:2GCEC130771625055) with an inoperable headlight. Once the defendant turned left to head eastbound on Brandon Boulevard East, the Silverado weaved from side-to-side crossing into both the right and left lanes. Deputy Ream activated his patrol vehicle's emergency lights to conduct a traffic stop of the Silverado which displayed a delayed reaction before pulling over by approximately .25 mile. On contact with the driver/defendant, Deputy Ream detected indicators of impairment to include; bloodshot glassy eyes, the strong and distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath, he spoke with slurred speech, he demonstrated flight-of-ideas by forgetting to retrieve his vehicle's registration which Deputy Ream requested several times, and he changed the location he was coming from several times. The affiant responded to the scene and on contact with the defendant, she detected further indicators of impairment to include a soiled right cheek with a food substance, and he stood with an orbital sway. The affiant requested the defendant perform field sobriety exercises of which he refused to do all but the HGN/VGN exercise. Based on the totality of the circumstances and the indicators or impairment observed, the affiant arrested the defendant for Driving Under the Influence. The defendant was transported to Central Breath Testing where after a proper twenty-minute observation period was conducted he provided two lawful breath samples of .240/.245% B.A.C. respectively. The defendant identified himself via Florida Driver License.
