The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

Officer Rizzo observed the defendant driving a black Mercedes with FL tag LFMD03 on the roadway. She made a left turn from the straight lane cutting off traffic that was in the left turn lane. She conducted a traffic stop and made contact with the defendant who was in the driver's seat of the vehicle. Upon contact she could smell the odor of alcoholic beverages from her breath. She was slurring her words. She was confused about why she was pulled over after Officer Rizzo explained it to her several times and she asking the same questions over and over. When Officer Rizzo instructed her to get out to the vehicle she refused to comply. Officer Rizzo attempted to take the defendant out of the vehicle after advising her she was under arrest. The defendant continued to refuse to get out of the car and was holding on to the car to avoid being removed from the vehicle by the officers. They eventually got her out of the vehicle and placed her in custody.

I made contact with the defendant and could smell a strong odor of alcoholic beverages from her breath. Her eyes were glassy and bloodshot. She was yelling and slurring her words. She refused to conduct field sobriety exercises. Post arrest I advised her of implied consent and she understood and refused to provide a breath sample.
