The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On March 26, 2020 at approximately 2115 hours, a concerned citizen called H.C.S.O. regarding a suspicious vehicle parked improperly in the neighborhood on the grass with the headlights on. Deputy N. Tejada (ABN:254169) arrived at the location reported by the complainant and observed a silver BMW X5 bearing Florida temporary tag: CQK4674 (V.I.N.:5UXFA13504LU24558) parked on the grass facing east perpendicular to the northbound lane of Bryan Road. The BMW X5's engine was on, the gear selector was in drive, and the driver/defendant was passed out behind the wheel. After numerous attempts at waking the defendant by knocking on both the passenger and driver side windows, Deputy Tejada entered the car via the unlocked driver side door to put the vehicle in park and remove the key from the ignition. The defendant only woke after Deputy Tejada yelled and shone a flashlight on the defendant's face. After ensuring the defendant was not having a medical emergency, Deputy Tejada detected indicators of impairment displayed by the defendant to include disorientation (could not state where she was coming from or where she was going), the distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath, she nearly fell when she exited the vehicle, she leaned on the BMW for balance, and she displayed ultra sensitivity to light (kept blocking headlights in the distance with her hands). In addition, there was an open glass containing a burgundy liquid emanating the odor of an alcoholic beverage in plain view resting on the top of the front passenger seat next to the defendant's purse. The affiant responded to the scene and observed the aforementioned indicators of impairment (minus vehicle exit) as well as bloodshot glassy eyes, unsteadiness on her feet while walking, standing with a noticeable sway, almost falling several times, and the inability to recall basic information such as her address and phone number. The affiant requested the defendant perform field sobriety exercises which she agreed to do. Throughout the performance of the exercises, the defendant displayed indicators of impairment and was subsequently arrested for Driving Under the Influence. The defendant was transported to Central Breath Testing where after a proper twenty minute observation period she provided two lawful breath samples of .266/.266% B.A.C. respectively. The defendant identified herself via Florida Driver License.
