NARRATIVE:

On or about Friday, July 14, 2020 at 1342 hours Sergeant Ott ID #7125 of the Violent Crimes Division (Homicide) requested that your Affiant respond to 247 Edwards Lane in the town of Palm Beach Shore (Substation 20). He told your Affiant that an off-duty Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) Deputy was followed and assaulted by two individuals.

Your Affiant arrived at about 1442 hours and met Sergeant Langevin ID #36148 who said that Deputy Russian ID #36144 is the involved off-duty deputy. Your Affiant met D/S Russian and he agreed to provide a sworn audio statement. The following is information that your Affiant learned and is not to be considered verbatim. Deputy Russian is assigned to the PBSO Road Patrol Division at District 20 Palm Beach Shores. He also lives in the town of Palm Beach Shores. He has an assigned marked PBSO vehicle that he takes home. While on-duty D/S Russian operates his marked PBSO vehicle and wears his issued PBSO green Road Patrol uniform. His uniform consist of a silver PBSO star and PBSO patches. D/S Russian said he was been involved in three separate incidents with two individuals in Palm Beach Shores. Two of the incidents occurred on-duty and one was off-duty. The two individuals were later identified as Fred Spring DOB: 1/03/96 and Carson Shoaf DOB: 3/04/97. The following are these incidents chronologically;

On or about July 4, 2020 at 1730 hours Deputy Russian was on-duty in the town of Palm Beach Shores. He was in his PBSO uniform driving his marked PBSO vehicle. He said he was patrolling near 31 Ocean Ave inlet access when he saw Spring and

Shoaf get dropped off. He said they were both carrying spear fishing guns and walking towards the intercostal waterway. Deputy Russian said the inlet/ beaches were closed this weekend. He also said that it is illegal to spear fish in the intercostal waterways. He made a casual contact with Spring and Shoaf and informed them of this information. Deputy Grammatico ID #28985 was also present during this encounter. Spring began verbally attacking D/S Russian. He said, "Fuck you" and "Fuck you Faggot boy." D/S Russian attempted to defuse the situation several times but both were verbally aggressive towards him. Both Spring and Shoaf eventually left the area. On or about July 9, 2020 at 0645 hours D/S Russian was on-duty in the town of Palm Beach Shores. He was in his PBSO uniform driving his marked PBSO vehicle. He was requested by the PBSO Narcotics Unit to assist with a residential search warrant at 140 Bravado Lane. Agent [REDACTED] was the lead investigator for that narcotic investigation under PBSO case number 20-602. D/S Russian was asked to provide scene security for the Narcotic Agents. While on scene he learned that Shoaf lives at this residence. He said he detained Shoaf inside his marked PBSO vehicle for the Narcotic Agents. He didn't at first recognize Shoaf as the person he had previously encountered. He said Spring showed up to the scene and began verbally attacking him again. This is when he remembered both Spring and Shoaf from the previous encounter. He said they both accused him of being the reason their house was being searched. They both yelled obscenities at D/S Russian and said they know where he lives. D/S Russian lives on [REDACTED] D/S Russian learned that two firearms were seized from 140 Bravado Ln. D/S Russian believes that both Shoaf and Spring live at this residence. Your Affiant later confirmed through Agent [REDACTED] that Shoaf lives at this residence.

On or about July 14, 2020 at 1030 hours D/S Russian was off-duty in plain clothes. He was driving his personally owned vehicle in the town of Palm Beach Shores traveling west on Bravado Ln. At the intersection of Atlantic Avenue, he observed a blue Chevy Cobalt traveling south on Atlantic Ave. The vehicle turned left in front of him to travel east on Bravado Ln. As the vehicle passed him he saw Spring and Shoaf inside. Shoaf was driving and Spring was in the front passenger seat. He said he continued east on Bravado Ln and watched the Chevy Cobalt pull into 140 Bravado Ln. The vehicle then exited and traveled east on Bravado Ln tailgating D/S Russian. He said due to Shoaf and Spring being in this vehicle he was afraid to go home. He said he felt this way due to the past verbal attacks and previous knowledge of them having firearms (Narcotics seizure on 7/09/20). D/S Russian traveled north on Lake Dr then turned into Sailfish Marina at 98 Lake Dr. While traveling D/S Russian called on-duty D/S Grammatico ID #28985 telling her about Spring and Shoaf following him. Spring and Shoaf continued to follow D/S Russian south through the Marina. D/S Russian said he traveled south then east through the parking lot to get away from Spring and Shoaf. He said Shoaf aggressively put his vehicle in front of his blocking him from continuing east. D/S Russian said he got out of his vehicle first because he didn't want

to become a victim. D/S Russian said that Spring got out of the passenger side of the vehicle and stated, "I'm going to beat your fucking ass." Spring said, "I know where your wife and daughter are at, I know where you live." D/S Russian said Spring had an aggressive posture clenching his fists and he thought he was going to be attacked. D/S Russian said he stated to Spring, "I'll end you if you come to my house." D/S Russian said Shoaf was recording this incident with his cellphone. D/S Grammatico and D/S Santos ID #24636 arrived and separated everyone. He said Spring and Shoaf moved their vehicle to another location in the parking lot. He said the manager of Sailfish Marina came out and requested Spring and Shoaf to be trespass warned. D/S Russian left the scene going to his residence on [REDACTED]. He said he met Deputy Singer ID #36149 at his home and was standing in the driveway. He said he was trading vehicle keys with D/S Singer. D/S Russian observed a black vehicle stop in front of his residence. The passenger window rolled down he saw Spring in the driver's seat and Shoaf in the front passenger seat. He said both Shoaf and Spring again threatened to beat his ass and yelled obscenities. They both yelled again "we know where you live." They then left the area traveling east on Bravado Ln.

Your Affiant then met Deputy Grammatico who agreed to provide me a sworn audio statement. The following is information was learned from D/S Grammatico and should not be considered verbatim. D/S Grammatico received a phone call from D/S Russian that two individuals were following him and he was going to Sailfish Marina. She arrived and observed a blue vehicle parked at an angle in front of D/S Russian's vehicle. She saw Spring and D/S Russian near each other about two feet away. She said Spring was standing in the doorway to the blue vehicle on the passenger side. He said Spring was calling D/S Russian a "Fuck Boy" and yelling, "I hate cops." She said Spring was yelling at D/S Russian saying that he set up the search warrant at his house. She said Shoaf told her that he was recording this incident and that his father is internal affairs for Jacksonville Police Department. She said she heard Spring say he knows where D/S Russian lives. She said she heard D/S Russian say if he (Spring) comes to his residence he will end him. D/S Grammatico witnessed Spring threaten the manager of Sailfish Marina saying he was going to beat his ass for trespassing him. D/S Grammatico said D/S Russian left the scene before Spring and Shoaf. Spring and Shoaf left the scene several minutes later. D/S Grammatico did not activate her in car video/ audio due to wanting to assist D/S Russian quickly.

Your Affiant then met Deputy Santos who agreed to provide a sworn audio statement. The following is information learned from D/S Santos and should not be considered verbatim. D/S Santos said he received a call from D/S Grammatico in reference to D/S Russian being followed by someone. He said when he arrived he parked near the blue vehicle containing Spring and Shoaf. He said Spring was verbally aggressive towards D/S Russian and himself. He said he attempted to calm Spring down but was verbally attacked by Spring. He said Spring told him, "take your badge

off, I'll fucking beat your ass." Spring yelled several obscenities at D/S Santos and was physically aggressive. He said Shoaf also yelled at him telling him, "take off your badge, I'll beat your ass." D/S Santos said he didn't activate his in car video/ audio due to not knowing what was going on with this incident.

Your Affiant then spoke to Deputy Singer over the phone. He agreed to provide a sworn audio statement due to traveling out of state. The following is information learned from D/S Singer and should not be considered verbatim. He said he arrived at D/S Russian's residence on Bravado Ln to exchange some vehicle keys. He said while standing in the driveway a black vehicle slowed down almost coming to a complete stop. He said the passenger window rolled down and there were two young white males in the vehicle. He said they yelled, "Faggot ass, I'm going to beat your ass." He said the vehicle occupants yelled more obscenities then left the area. D/S Singer said he didn't know the occupants of the vehicle.

Det. Householder ID #20354 assisted with collecting security video from Sailfish Marina. I watched the video and observed D/S Russian's vehicle enter the Marina with the blue Chevy Cobalt following behind. D/S Russian then travels south then east in the parking lot. The blue Chevy stops in front (nose to nose) with D/S Russian and angles the front of the vehicle to prevent D/S Russian from traveling further. D/S Russian gets out and walks to the front of the blue Chevy. The front passenger gets out and can be seen exchanging words with D/S Russian. D/S Grammatico and D/S Santos then arrive and separate all parties. There is no audio on the video I was shown.



On or about July 14, 2020 at 1950 hours Spring and Shoaf were taken into custody by D/S Sullivan ID #24745 per your Affiant's request. Spring was driving the black Ford Escape (HMLS79) with Shoaf in the front passenger side. Both were recording the encounter with their cellphones. This vehicle was towed to 3228 Gun Club Rd. The phones and vehicle was sealed with Spring and Shoaf's cellphones inside. Spring and Shoaf were transported to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO) Violent Crimes Division, 3228 Gun Club Rd. I spoke with Shoaf who agreed to speak with me. After informing him of his constitutional warnings he agreed to speak with me. He asked if this incident was involving the incident with the deputy. After I told him the I was investigating that incident he requested legal counsel.

Next I spoke to Spring who agreed to speak with me post constitutional warnings. He said he knows D/S Russian and that his first encounter with him was about 2 weeks ago. He said he was going to the beach and carrying a spear gun with Shoaf. He said D/S Russian told them they couldn't spearfish in the ocean. Spring said he didn't like how D/S Russian came at him so he called him names like, "Fuck Boy." He said his next encounter with D/S Russian was when PBSO raided his mom's residence at 140

Bravado Ln. He said D/S Russian was aggressive to him and they yelled obscenities at each other. He said his third encounter with D/S Russian was earlier today. He said D/S Russian was sitting in a dark pickup truck in front of his mom's residence at 140 Bravado Ln. for no reason. He said D/S Russian almost hit him with his vehicle earlier in the day. He said at the time he didn't know D/S Russian was driving this vehicle. He said he went to 140 Bravado Ln. to get Shoaf's wallet. He said they then left the residence to go to Sailfish Marina to get food. He said the dark pickup truck stopped in front of him and Shoaf. He said D/S Russian then got out screaming at them. He said he yelled back at him but did not threaten him. When I explained the information from the video and statements Spring said, "we are done."

Based upon this investigation Shoaf and Spring willfully, maliciously, repeatedly followed, harassed, and made credible threats to D/S Russian. Probable Cause exists to believe Spring and Shoaf violated F.S.S. 784.048 (3) Aggravated Stalking. Shoaf and Spring threatened D/S Russian and D/S Santos (law enforcement officers) serious bodily harm. Probable Cause also exists to believe Spring and Shoaf violated F.S.S. 836.12 (2).
