DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On 12/07/2020 at approximately 23:07hrs, I was called to the scene of a possible impaired driver at the intersection of River Bridge Blvd and Meadow Lake Dr, which is located in the City of Greenacres, Florida. I arrived at the scene at approximately 2318hrs. D/S Baynam 36838 relayed to me, and completed a written signed sworn supplemental Probable Cause Affidavit stating the following, "On Monday, 12/7/20 at approximately 2300 hours, I responded to the area of River Bridge Blvd and Meadowlake Dr in the City of Greenacres in reference to a subject passed out behind the wheel of a vehicle.

Upon my arrival, I observed a blue Chevrolet Sedan bearing FL Tag # KFII26 stop at the stop sign. I approached the vehicle and observed a W/M wearing a black hoodie a sleep behind the wheel. The vehicle was running and still in drive. The W/M was the sole occupant of the vehicle. Before waking the W/M up, I observed a glass Miller Lite bottle in the center console. Deputies performed a sternum rub on the W/M to try and wake him up. After several attempts the W/M woke up. A strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage came from the W/M. The W/M had glossy blood shot eyes and slurred speech when he would speak. The W/M was identified as Chad Metzler by his Florida Drivers License." D/S Baynam 36838 noticed that the defendant had articulable indicators of impairment, so he called for a DUI unit to conduct a possible DUI investigation. D/S Baynam 36838 identified the defendant, to me, as the driver and sole occupant of the vehicle.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

Upon making contact with the driver who was identified by his Florida Driver License as Chad Robert Metzler, I immediately detected an obvious and strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his person and face area. This odor intensified as I spoke to Metzler. Metzler had glassy, glazed, and blood shot eyes. Metzler's speech was slurred, slow, thick, and at times difficult to understand. Metzler's movements were slow and deliberate. Metzler was lethargic in his movements with poor coordination. Metzler had an unsteady gait while walking to my patrol vehicle. Metzler was wearing a black sweat shirt, khaki shorts, and white and black sandals.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

Pre Miranda Metzler stated that he was coming from a friends house and was unaware that he fell asleep at the stop sign.

Post Miranda during the Q and A Metzler stated that he had 4-5 beers while eating dinner but that he was not under the influence.

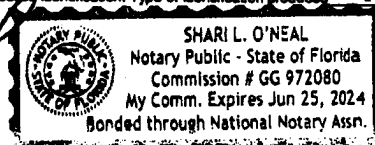

Metzler would sway roughly in a side to side front to back pattern throughout the task. Metzler did positively identify the point to be tracked.

WALK & TURN:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Walk & Turn" to Metzler who stated that he understood. During the task, I observed Metzler to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Metzler could not maintain his balance while listening to instructions. Metzler missed heel-to-toe steps and stepped off the line.

ONE LEG STAND:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "One Leg Stand" to Metzler who stated that he understood. During the task, I observed Metzler to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Metzler continued to sway while balancing on one leg.

FINGER TO NOSE:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Finger to Nose" task to Metzler who stated that he understood. During the task, I observed Metzler to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Metzler's index finger did not touch the nose on 6 of 6 attempts. The sequence used for this task was L, R, L, R, R, L.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

I explained and demonstrated the instructions for the "Rhombert Alphabet" task to Metzler who stated that he understood. During the task, I observed Metzler to sway roughly in a side to side, front to back pattern throughout the demonstration phase. Metzler would sway more than 2 inches. Metzler correctly recited the alphabet.

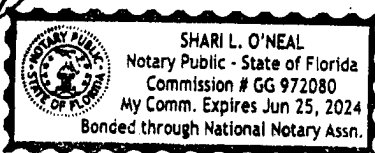

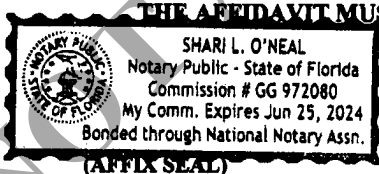
