UNLAWFULLY AND WITHOUT INVITATION OR LICENSE DID ENTER OR REMAIN IN THAT CERTAIN STRUCTURE, TO-WIT: 5756 CALAIS BLVD, ST. PETERSBURG FL 33714 AFOREMENTIONED THE PROPERTY OF LAUREN BELICH AND DESTINY CRAWFORD, WITH THE INTENT TO COMMIT AN OFFENSE THEREIN, AND DURING THE COURSE THEREOF DID ASSAULT UPON LAUREN BELICH BY FORCING THE FRONT DOOR OF THE RESIDENCE OPEN AND FORCING OPEN A CLOSET SHE WAS HIDING IN, IN ORDER TO ENTER THE SAID STRUCTURE AT THE TIME WAS NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

THE DEFENDANT FORCIBLY ENTERED THE HOME AND THEN RAN UP TO THE SECOND STORY MASTER BEDROOM. THE DEFENDANT THEN SAW THE VICTIM WAS HIDING IN THE MASTER BEDROOM CLOSET. THE DEFENDANT THEN PUT THE VICTIM IN FEAR BY FORCIBLY OPENING THE CLOSET DOOR. IN THE PROCESS OF OPENING THE CLOSET DOOR, HE BROKE IT OFF THE HINGES. THE DEFENDANT ALSO CAUSED MINOR INJURIES TO HIMSELF IN THE PROCESS OF ATTEMPTING TO OPEN THE CLOSET DOOR. ONCE THE DEFENDANT OPENED THE CLOSET DOOR, HE ENTERED THE CLOSET AND BEGAN YELLING AT THE VICTIM. THE DEFENDANT THEN LEFT THE RESIDENCE AFTER LEARNING LAW ENFORCEMENT WAS ON SCENE. THE DEFENDANT WAS STOPPED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT WHEN LEAVING THE SCENE.

UNLAWFULLY AND WITHOUT INVITATION OR LICENSE DID ENTER OR REMAIN IN THAT CERTAIN STRUCTURE, TO-WIT: 5756 CALAIS BLVD, ST. PETERSBURG FL 33714 AFOREMENTIONED THE PROPERTY OF LAUREN BELICH AND DESTINY CRAWFORD, WITH THE INTENT TO COMMIT AN OFFENSE THEREIN, AND DURING THE COURSE THEREOF DID BATTERY UPON DESTINY CRAWFORD BY FORCING THE FRONT DOOR OF THE RESIDENCE OPEN AND PUSHING HER IN ORDER TO ENTER THE SAID STRUCTURE AT THE TIME WAS NOT OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

THE DEFENDANT WENT TO THE VICTIMS RESIDENCE AND BEGAN ATTEMPTING TO OPEN THE FRONT DOOR. THE VICTIM TOLD THE DEFENDANT TO LEAVE, AT WHICH TIME HE REMOVED THE "PEEP" HOLE FROM THE DOOR. THE DEFENDANT STARTED YELLING THROUGH THE HOLE IN THE DOOR FOR THE VICTIM TO OPEN IT. THE VICTIM CONTINUED TO REFUSE. THE DEFENDANT THEN CLIMB TO THE SECOND STORY OF THE RESIDENCE, AND BEGAN "BANGING" ON THE MASTER BEDROOM WINDOW. THE DEFENDANT THEN CLIMBED DOWN AND WENT TO THE FIRST FLOOR, AT WHICH TIME HE RAN INTO THE NEIGHBOR. THE VICTIM HEARD THE NEIGHBOR OUTSIDE AND OPENED THE DOOR TO APOLOGIZE FOR THE NOISE. AT THIS TIME THE DEFENDANT SAW THE DOOR WAS OPEN AND FORCED HIS WAY IN. THE VICTIM ATTEMPTED TO AVOID ENTRY BY CLOSING THE DOOR. THE DEFENDANT THEN PUSHED THE DOOR OPEN MAKING ENTRY INTO THE HOME. THE VICTIM ATTEMPTED TO PUSH THE DEFENDANT BACK OUTSIDE, AT WHICH TIME THE DEFENDANT PUSHED THE VICTIM WITH OPEN HANDS, MAKING HER LOSE HER BALANCE. THE DEFENDANT THEN WENT UP TO THE SECOND STORY OF THE RESIDENCE WERE HIS EX-GIRLFRIEND, LAUREN BELICH, WAS HIDING. THE DEFENDANT THEN DAMAGED A CLOSET DOOR IN ORDER TO GET TO LAUREN. THE DEFENDANT THEN LEFT THE RESIDENCE AFTER BEING NOTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT HAD ARRIVED. THE DEFENDANT WAS STOPPED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT WHEN LEAVING THE RESIDENCE.

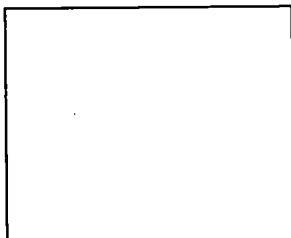
