Probable Cause

On 4/21/2020 I Trooper Monique Masterson (4467) was dispatched at approximately 10:25PM to a traffic stop located northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) north of State Road 794 (Yamato Road) in the construction zone.

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I arrived on scene at approximately 11:00PM. I observed a black sedan in the road closure for the construction zone. I approached the traffic stop initiating officer, Detective Travis Denson at his patrol vehicle with his lights activated. Detective Denson explained that he witnessed the black sedan drive at a slow rate of speed and run over the cones that tapered off the construction zone. I observed the cones that were ran over. Detective Denson informed me that he noticed the sole occupant who was the driver of the vehicle, to have a slurred speech and was slow to respond to commands and was unaware that her vehicle was in reverse.

I made contact with the driver of the black sedan bearing the New Jersey tag of "ZSW58Z. The driver of the vehicle was a white female wearing a black top. The driver was later identified through a New Jersey driver license (D26181226161652) as Cheryl Depaola. Ms. Depaola was smoking a cigarette when I approached the vehicle. I asked Ms. Depaola if she had run over some cones in the construction zone. Ms. Depaola said yes but she didn't notice at first. I noticed Ms. Depaola was lethargic as I spoke with her. I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage as I spoke with Ms. Depaola in the vehicle. I had Ms. Depaola exit the vehicle. Ms. Depaola stumbled out of her vehicle and had to use the side of her car to remain standing. I had to instruct Ms. Depaola multiple times to stand at the rear of her vehicle. Ms. Depaola swayed as she stood at the rear of her vehicle. I could smell on obvious odor of an alcoholic beverage omitting from Ms. Depaola breath as I continued to ask Ms. Depaola questions. I asked Ms. Depaola if she had consumed any alcohol prior to being stopped. Ms. Depaola stated she did not drink anything and that she was not drunk. Ms. Depaola stated "I'm fine, I just want to go and see my son". I notified Ms. Depaola that I could smell the odor of alcohol omitting from her breath even while she wore a handkerchief around her nose and mouth.

I informed Ms. Depaola that I was conducting a DUI investigation based on the indicators that I observed during the traffic stop. I explained some of the indicators that I observed to Ms. Depaola. I then asked Ms. Depaola if she would like to perform Field Sobriety Exercise (SFST) to demonstrate her level of sobriety. Ms. Depaola agreed to do SFST. I instructed her to walk to the white line in front of my marked patrol vehicle. I had to instruct Ms. Depaola multiple times which line and

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which vehicle to stand in front of to perform the exercises. Ms. Depaola stumbled to the line.

Indicators:

- The obvious smell of an alcoholic beverage omitting from Ms. Bender breathe.
- Glossy red eyes
- Flushed face
- Slight slurred speech
- Swaying and unbalanced
- Driving at slow speeds
- Driving over cones and not noticing
- Difficulties with remembering instructions
- Stumbling when walking

I asked Ms. Depaola if she had any medical problems or issues with head, eyes, neck, back, legs, knees, or feet. I asked Ms. Depaola if she had any balance issues or any medical issues that would prevent her from performing the exercises properly. Ms. Depaola stated that she does wear glasses. Ms. Depaola wore her glasses during the exercises. Ms. Bender stated she had no medical problems or issues with head, eyes, neck, legs, knees, or feet. Ms. Depaola stated she broke her back skate boarding 2 months prior. Ms. Depaola stated she's not good at balance. I asked Ms. Depaola if she had been in a crash recently. Ms. Depaola state no. I asked Ms. Depaola if she was diabetic. Ms. Depaola stated no. I asked Ms. Depaola if she takes medication. Ms. Depaola stated she takes medication for Bipolar. I asked Ms. Depaola if she takes any other drugs legal or not legal. Ms. Depaola stated no. I asked Ms. Depaola if she had other shoes shed like to perform the exercises in. Ms. Depaola stated she does not. I informed Ms. Depaola if at any time she does not feel comfortable doing the exercises with the shoes she's in she can redo the exercises without any shoes on.

The first exercise was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. Ms. Depaola was placed in the starting position of standing up straight with feet together and arms by his side. I instructed Ms. Depaola to keep her head and body still during the

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entirety of the first exercise. I explained to Ms. Depaola that I would move my pen from side to side and for her to move her eyes only. I asked Ms. Depaola if she understood the instructions. Ms. Depaola stated that she understood. Ms. Depaola moved her head multiple times during the exercise. Ms. Depaola had an obvious sway during the exercise. Ms. Depaola had a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes, distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes, and onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. Vertical Gaze Nystagmus was not tested

The second exercise was the Walk and Turn. I instructed and demonstrated Ms. Depaola to place her left foot on the line followed by her right foot in front of her left foot touching heel to toe multiple times. I explained and demonstrated to Ms. Depaola that her arms are to stay by her side and not to raise at any point during this exercise multiple times. I instructed and demonstrated to Ms. Depaola to stay in that position (the starting position) while I give the rest of the instruction to the test. I specifically instructed Ms. Depaola to not begin the exercise until told to do so. I explained and demonstrated to Ms. Depaola, when I tell her to begin that her first step will be with her left foot. I instructed and demonstrated to Ms. Depaola that she will take nine heel to toe steps and to count out loud what number step she was on while looking at her steps. I instructed and demonstrated the turn portion of the exercise that comes after the ninth step. I explained to Ms. Depaola the turn will consist of her keeping her lead foot on the ground and pivoting off of it with a series of small steps using her other foot. I informed Ms. Depaola to verbally notify me when she has completed the exercise. I asked Ms. Depaola if she understood the instructions throughout giving the instructions. Ms. Depaola stated she did understand the questions. When Ms. Depaola did not understand or needed an instruction repeated she asked for me to repeat it to her. I repeated all instructions she asked me to repeat. Ms. Depaola started the exercise prior to being instructed to start. Ms. Depaola failed to stay in the ready position during the period of instruction and struggled to maintain balance while in the ready position. Ms. Depaola preformed an improper turn. Ms. Depaola stepped off the line during the exercise multiple times. Ms. Depaola used her arms for balance. Ms. Depaola did not count steps out loud while going down or back up the line. Ms. Depaola did not walk heel to toe during the exercise. Ms. Depaola took more than 9 steps.

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The third exercise was the One Leg Stand. I instructed and demonstrated to Ms. Depaola to stand with feet together and arms by her side; the same as the first exercise. I specifically informed Ms. Depaola to not begin the exercise until told to do so. I explained and demonstrated to Ms. Depaola that she will pick up any leg of choice and raise it above the ground approximately six inches and to look at her foot until told to place her foot back on the ground. I instructed Ms. Depaola to count out loud the seconds that pass by while her foot is raised above the ground. I informed Ms. Depaola to not place her foot on the ground unless she felt they were going to fall. I asked Ms. Depaola if she understood the instructions throughout giving the instructions. Ms. Depaola stated she understood. Ms. Depaola put her foot on the ground multiple times during the exercise. Ms. Depaola lost balance by using arms and using both feet on the ground to regain balance multiple times Ms. Depaola did not count out loud at some moments during the exercise. Ms. Depaola had a noticeable sway during the exercise. Ms. Depaola stopped during the exercise and I told him to continue. Ms. Depaola hopped during the exercise. Ms. Depaola could barely perform the exercise. Ms. Depaola asked if she could do the exercise again. I allowed her to do the exercise again. Ms. Depaola performed in the same manner as the prior exercise.

Clues:

- Lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes
- Distinct and sustained Nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes
- Onset of Nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes

Walk and turn

- started the exercise prior to being instructed to start
- failed to stay in the ready position during the period of instruction
- performed an improper turn
- Did not touch heel to toe
- stepped off the line
- used his arms for balance
- Took more than 9 steps

One leg stand

- Sways while balancing
- Put his foot on the ground

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-Using arms for balance
-Hopped

Based on the initial indicators that I observed on scene during the traffic stop and the clues that I observed during the SFST exercises, I placed Ms. Depaola under arrest for DUI (Florida Statute 316.193) at 11:20 PM on 4/21/2020.

After placing Ms. Depaola in handcuffs, I conducted a thorough search of her. I placed Ms. Depaola in the rear right seat of my patrol car. During the inventory of the vehicle I discovered 3 unopened travel bottles of chardonnay and a bottle cap of a Chardonnay. I was unable to locate the fourth bottle. I located the three bottles in a travel box with four empty spaces. I discovered a receipt stating a bottle of red wine was purchased at approximately 4:00PM 4/21/2020. Ms. Depaola requested to make a call on her cell phone. I searched the vehicle 3 separate times to locate her cell phone. I was unable to locate it.

At approximately 12:15AM 4/22/20, Ms. Depaola was transported to the Palm Beach County Breathe Alcohol Test facility (BAT). Ms. Depaola arrived at 12:42AM. At the BAT facility Ms. Depaola refused to give a sample of her breath for the purposes of determining her level of alcohol. Ms. Depaola refused at 1:07am.

Ms. Depaola was walked over to the Palm Beach County Jail. I released custody of Ms. Depaola to the Palm Beach county jail. Ms. Depaola was cited for Florida statues 316.078 (Drive around barricade) and 316.193(DUI). All above events occurred in Palm Beach County Florida.

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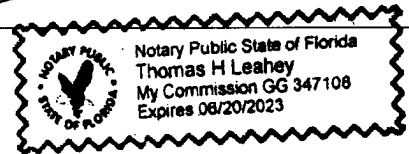

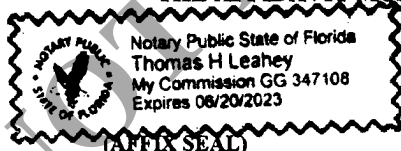
