Probable Cause

On 10/05/2020 at approximately 9:35pm I was traveling northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9)

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approaching Southern Blvd (State Road 80) when I observed a white Jeep Grand Cherokee bearing Florida tag (JTXN09) traveling at a high rate of speed in the outside lane. I visually estimated the speed to be over 100mph. I approached the vehicle from the rear and started to pace clocked the white Jeep. The driver later identified by her Minnesota Driver's license (K011167500302) as Courtney R. Faue didn't realize I was behind her vehicle and she continued to travel at 95mph pace in a posted 65mph speed limit zone. I paced clocked Ms. Faue's speed for approximately six seconds before activating my lights and sirens conducting a traffic stop and a welfare check to ask Ms. Faue the reason for traveling at a high rate of speed. Ms. Faue pulled to the left emergency shoulder, I approached the vehicle and immediately smelled a strong odor unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath. I observed that Ms. Faue's eyes were red, constricted and watery. I advised Ms. Faue that the reason I pulled her over was due to her high rate of speed. I asked Ms. Faue if she was ok, and the reason for her speed. Ms. Faue stated she was speeding to get to her co-worker who was involved in a domestic dispute with her husband. I asked Ms. Faue if she had anything to drink, which she stated she had one drink at 1pm. I later asked her to exit the vehicle and spoke to her in front of my marked patrol vehicle. I continued to smell the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from her breath as she spoke. I asked her if she was willing to perform standardized field sobriety exercises and Ms. Faue agreed to perform them. Prior to administering the exercises I asked if she had any medical conditions and she stated no. I asked if she was taking any medications and she stated no. I asked if she wore glasses or contacts and she stated no. (Note: The summary below is not intended to be a verbatim account of all the events that took place during the administration of the standardized field sobriety exercises. Video footage and audio of the exercises is available upon request.) Each exercise was explained and demonstrated prior to the subject attempting to perform the exercise.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Exercise (Streamlight red LED pen used as a contrasting stimulus)

- I checked for equal pupil size and equal tracking; Both pupils were equal in size and both eyes tracked the stimulus equally.
- I observed a lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes
- I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes
- I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus prior to 45 degrees in both eyes

Walk and Turn Exercise (A yellow line was constructed using duck tape)

- Did not keep arms to her side, used arms to balance
- Did not count out her steps

One Leg Stand Exercise

- Did not keep arms to her side, use arms to balance
- Did not perform exercise as instructed
- She had foot higher than 6 inches as instructed

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-Did not keep foot parallel

Based upon the performance of the above exercises and the totality of the circumstances I determined that there was probable cause to believe that Courtney R. Faue committed the offense of driving under the influence by being in actual physical control/operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcoholic beverages, any chemical substance per Florida State Statute 877.111, or any controlled substance per Chapter 893, while their normal faculties were impaired. Mr. Faue was placed under arrest for the above offense and handcuffed behind her back double spaced and tightening. After being searched she was placed in the backseat of my marked patrol vehicle. She was later transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing (BAT) facility. At the BAT facility a 20-minute observation period was conducted where she did not ingest anything by mouth or regurgitate (mouth was confirmed to be empty prior to beginning of the observation period). She was then asked to provide a breath test sample to test for the alcoholic content of her breath. She refused to give a breath test sample. I then read her the Florida Implied Consent driver's license suspension warning and asked her again if she would provide a breath sample. She refused again to give a breath test sample. The Constitutional Warning document was then read to her and she stated that she understood her rights and agreed to answer my questions. See BAT video footage for the complete question and answer interview portion. She was issued a DUI citation along with a uniform traffic citation for unlawful speed. She was subsequently booked without incident. All the above events occurred in Palm Beach County, FL.



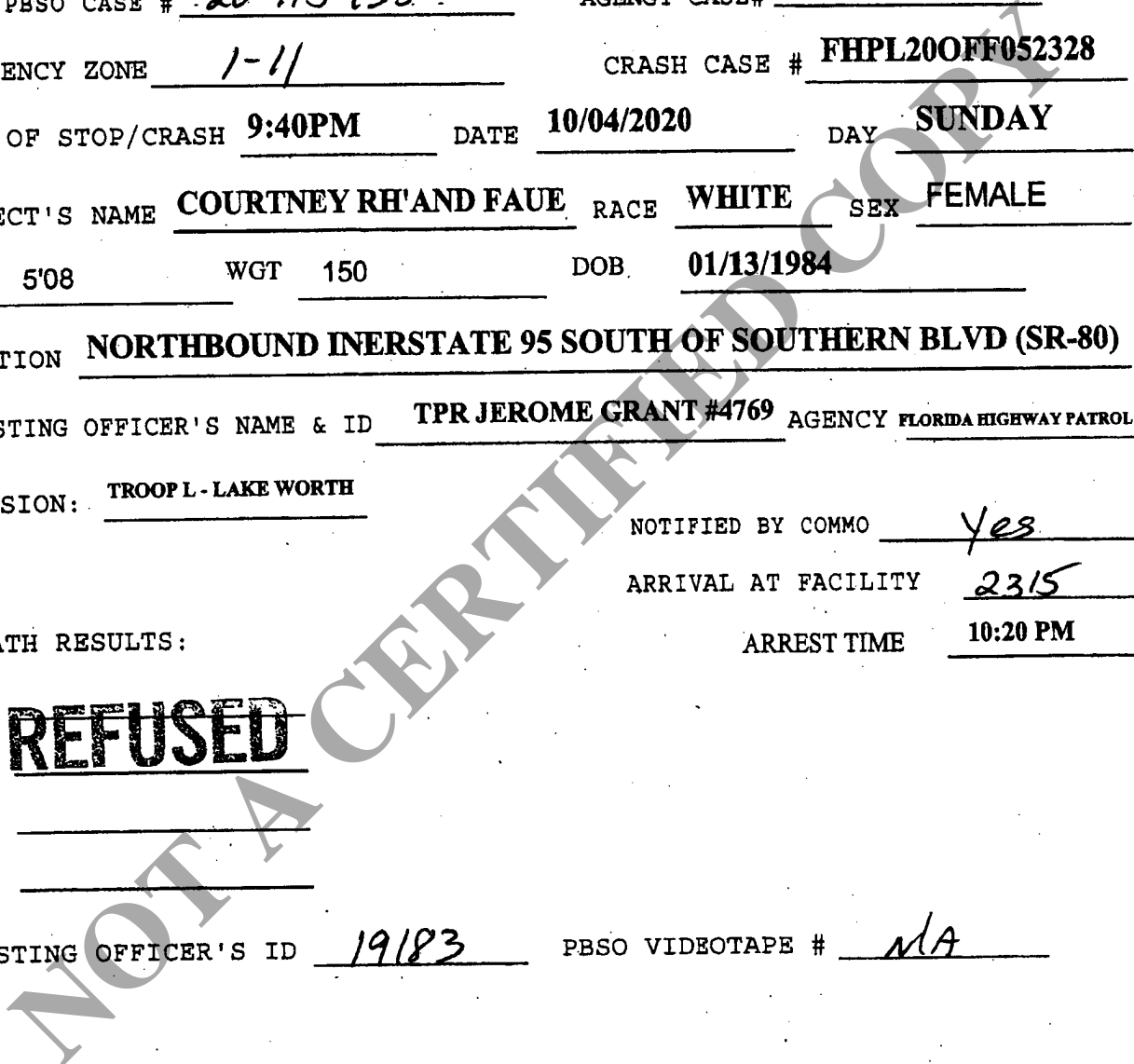

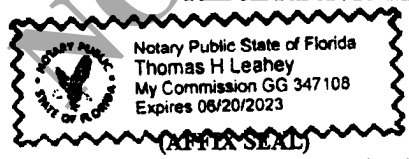
