Before me this date personally appeared AMARIS, BELISARIO (18017) who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on 29 day of April, (year) 2017 at 8330 SANDS POINT BLVD N105, TAMARAC, FL 33321 (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows
video, I determined the following:

The neighbor as referred by the complainants' statement was identified as Daniel Millan (Defendant). The victim, a two year white male, was under the supervision of the defendant. On 04/29/17 between 8:15pm and 8:30 pm, the defendant walked outside his apartment (8330 Sands Point Blvd, Apartment #103) with the victim, a two year and walked to the back of the building which faces an unprotected canal and has poor lightning and has low visibility. The victim was only wearing no clothing or shoes, but diapers. The defendant stood by the shore with the victim for a couple of minutes before walking back to the hallway which leads to the mailboxes. The victim was following the defendant on foot the entire time until the defendant willfully neglected the victim by leaving him unsupervised near the parking lot. The defendant walked back to his apartment, he then went inside and closed the front door without the child victim. In the meantime, the victim walked to the parking lot area and sat down near wall by the first parking space. The victim remained there unattended, unsupervised and unprotected by the defendant who was already inside his apartment. The victim was found by the witness who was driving by and almost struck the child who was just standing in the parking lot alone. The victim was picked up and brought back to apartment #103 by the witness. Subsequently, the witness called 911 to notify about this incident.

Based on the totality of the circumstances, the defendant failed to provide supervision essential for the well-being of the victim, a two year old child. Moreover, the defendant willfully neglected the child without causing bodily harm. The defendant was charged accordingly and he was transported to the main jail.
