On Tuesday, March 9, 2021 at 10:54am, Palm Beach County Animal Care and Control received a complaint of a fawn colored shepherd with sores on his body, hips, ribs and backbones are visible. The dog also had no shelter and unknown if he had access to food and water. Officer Carlee Balfe (Badge #2120) of Palm Beach County responded to the complaint.

Upon Officer Balfe's arrival to 15324 Key Lime Boulevard, Loxahatchee she met with Phil Smith who reported that there was a very skinny dog with its ribs, back, and hips showing in the backyard of a neighbor's home behind the garage.

Mr. Smith showed Officer Balfe the dog from the neighbor's yard. Officer Balfe observed an extremely skinny dog whose ribs were clearly visible and hipbones prominent. Officer Balfe observed the dog tethered to a concrete slab. Officer Balfe then contacted me by phone and requested my assistance on the complaint.

Upon my arrival to 15286 74th St, Loxahatchee I was able to meet with Officer Balfe who informed me that the dog was visible from the backyard of 15232 74th St, Loxahatchee. Officer Balfe stated that the owner of the property has granted us permission to view the dog from their property. We walked into the backyard and to the back fence. I was able to observe a tan Shepherd mix lying next to a wooden structure. The dog was tethered and seemed lethargic. I was able to observe ribs, hips and spine. I also observed that the dogs head was sunken in. I scored the dog a 5 on the TACC scale (Tufts Animal Care and Condition, 1 being of ideal weight and 5 being emaciated).

We then proceeded to 15324 Key Lime Blvd, Loxahatchee and we met with Danielle Badgley. I advised her who we were and the reason for our visit. I informed Mrs. Badgley that we received a complaint concerning a dog behind her garage. Mrs. Badgley stated that the dog was named Harley and that they kept him tethered because he was an escape artist. During that time, we were able to observe a tan Shepherd inside of the home barking from the window. I asked Mrs. Badgley if that dog was current on shots and tags and she replied 'no he was just a year old'. I asked to observe the dog whose name was Dax. We observed a tan 1-year-old male Shepherd mix. I was able to take two photos of Dax. Dax scored a 1 on the TACC scale.

After putting Dax back into the house, we then discussed Harley. Mrs. Badgley stated that Harley was old and skinny. She also stated that she thinks it is time for him to be put to sleep. I then asked if she would mind if we would take him. She then stated that she could call her vet out. I advised her that we could transport and have a vet look at Harley at ACC. Mrs. Badgley stated that she was not sure. I then asked if we all could go look at Harley. We then began to walk towards the backyard and Mrs. Badgley stated that her husband is the one that feeds and waters Harley and that she has not been back there to see him in at least three months.

When we got behind the garage, we could clearly see just how emaciated Harley was. All of his bones were protruding. Mrs. Badgley stated that she did not know he was that bad and stated that we could take him. Officer Balfe put a leash on Harley and began to walk

him to the front and I took a couple of photos of Harley's living conditions. I noticed that the silver bowl did not contain any food or water. I also checked the white five-pound bucket, which had pinecones and dirt inside. A makeshift wooden structure was what Harley used for shelter. The structure did not meet the requirements as required by county ordinance. Mrs. Badgley stated that Harley goes underneath the structure.

Upon arriving back in the front of the home, Officer Balfe began filling out the paperwork. Mrs. Badgley asked me what if she did not want to give Harley up and I advised her that I would have to seize Harley due to his condition. Mrs. Badgley signed an owner surrender form and Officer Balfe issued a violation to obtain rabies vaccination and county tag for Dax. After arriving back at the shelter, Harley was scanned for a microchip and the microchip was registered to Mrs. Badgley.

Dr. Sara Chapman examined Harley and concluded *"Harley arrived at the shelter as a TACC 5. He was severely emaciated, muscle wasted, and weak. Most of his skeletal structure was visible under his skin, including his ribs, vertebrae, spine of the scapula, femur, and hips. A layperson should have easily recognized that Harley was too skinny and was not receiving appropriate nutrition. It is likely that chronic lack of appropriate amount/quality of nutrition lead to Harley's poor body condition since he gained approximately 30 lbs over a 2-month period without any major medical intervention. Harley came into the shelter positive for internal parasitism (hookworms and heartworms). These internal parasites can cause weight loss or failure to thrive, but are unlikely to result in a TACC 5 body condition on their own. Hookworms are intestinal parasites that can cause diarrhea, weight loss, and anemia. Harley's hookworm infection was easily treated with a few days of deworming medication. Heartworm disease is a serious and potentially fatal disease in which worms grow in the blood vessels/heart/lungs and cause lasting damage. If left untreated, the disease can progress to congestive heart failure or caval syndrome (complete blockage of the vessels in the heart leading to cardiovascular collapse). Harley was not in stable enough condition on arrival to the shelter to be treated for heartworm disease. Harley was able to gain weight despite not receiving adulticide treatment for his heartworm disease, which further justifies that chronic malnutrition/starvation likely played a role in his poor body condition. Infections with hookworms or heartworms are avoidable with appropriate monthly preventative medications. Harley was undoubtedly suffering as his body began to breakdown its own muscle and fat to provide energy that was not being provided through his diet. Harley was living an inhumane life, as he did not have freedom from discomfort, hunger, or disease"*.

Mrs. Badgley admitted to Officer Balfe and myself that she had not seen Harley in at least three months. As an owner, Mrs. Badgely has a lawful responsibility to provide adequate food, water and shelter. Mrs. Badgely also has the responsibility to make sure Harley did not suffer or be in pain. Mrs. Badgely failed to do all these things as Harley slowly suffered, as his body began to breakdown his muscle and fat. Based on the above facts, probable cause exists to charge Danielle Badgley with F.S.S. animal cruelty 828.12.2 and F.S.S. 828.13


