The DEF Stated that he, "wanted to go home" and "no". When the DEF exited the vehicle, he started to sway from side to side and showed difficulty walking in a straight line. The DEF was read implied consent on scene, which he refused by stating "no". Due to my observations and interaction with the DEF, I believed he was operating a motor vehicle while being impaired beyond the legal limit and was arrested.
