<p>On 10/4/2020, at approximately 1423 hours, BRPD Detective Hanley and I were called out in reference to a stabbing that occurred at 2188 NW 53rd St, Boca Raton, FL 33496, which is located in the Broken Sound community.</p> <p>Upon our arrival the residence had been secured. I met with BRPD uniformed personnel who advised the following: On 10/4/2020, at 1311 hours, BRPD dispatch received a 911 call from 561-241-6479, but the caller said he did not need PD and hung up. BRPD uniformed personnel responded to the address associated with the phone number in BRPD records, 2188 NW 53rd St, and met with Michael Salit (DOB 7/21/43). Michael advised he was attempting to dial "411" to contact a friend but accidentally dialed "911." Michael's step-son, David Salit (DOB 4/24/1993), who lives at the residence with Michael had been struggling with depression and trying to cope with the death of his mother two and a half years ago. BRPD uniformed personnel met with David and assessed him for the Baker Act but determined that David did not meet the criteria. Officers then departed the residence.</p> <p>Shortly after BRPD units departed the residence, BRPD dispatch received a second 911 call from Michael on his phone (561-241-6479) at approximately 1347 hours. Michael reported that David had just stabbed him and fled the residence in his blue Ford Mustang bearing Florida tag BWYT08. BRPD units that were still in the Broken Sound neighborhood observed the vehicle leaving the scene northbound inside Broken Sound toward the Clint Moore Rd community gate at a high rate of speed. The vehicle continued westbound on Clint Moore Rd from the Broken Sound community gate, and then northbound on Jog Rd at a high rate of speed, at which point BRPD units lost sight of the vehicle.</p> <p>Uniformed personnel met with Michael. Michael explained that after the officers left the residence, he went upstairs to the master bedroom and sat down on the bed. Shortly</p>

after sitting down, David knocked on the door and requested to speak with Michael. Michael said he could not talk because he had a meeting. David entered the bedroom, approached Michael and stabbed him in the upper back with a large steak knife. The statement was audio and video recorded by BRPD officers' body-worn cameras. BRPD responded and transported Michael to Delray Beach Medical Center as a trauma patient (BRPD run number 20-11965). Doctors advised that Michael had a sharp force wound on his upper back that was roughly 2-3 inches deep. Michael was immediately admitted to surgery. Prior to the surgery, Michael Salit gave verbal consent to BRPD uniformed personnel for officers to enter the residence to process the scene and collect evidence.

BRPD CST Greco responded to the residence to conduct the crime scene investigation. CST Greco documented the scene by taking measurements and photographs. I observed a large steak knife, with a serrated blade that was approximately 5 to 7 inches long with a brown wooden handle, that was leaning against a box, blade down, on the floor next to the bed in the master bedroom. The knife had blood approximately halfway up the blade. I observed blood spatter on the carpet and the box around the knife and large amounts of blood in the attached master bathroom. A BRPD crime scene technician photographed the knife, collected it as evidence, and processed the scene for DNA.

BRPD dispatch received a call from the Seasons Community gate house (6401 N Jog Rd, Boca Raton, FL 33496) at approximately 1354 hours, that a blue mustang attempted to enter through the main gate. The vehicle was denied access at which point it fled the area, hitting a curb in the process which caused extensive damage to the front driver side tire. The caller at Seasons provided the license plate number of the vehicle, which matched David Salit's blue Ford Mustang. David's blue mustang was later located by security in the parking lot of 3003 W Yamato Rd, Boca Raton, FL 33434 (Woodfield Plaza) parked in the north west area of the parking lot. The vehicle was unoccupied and had heavy damage to the front driver side tire. BRPD units checked the area extensively for David Salit but were unable to locate him.

My investigation revealed that David Salit did knowing and intentionally cause great bodily harm with a deadly weapon to Michael Salit when he stabbed him in the back with a wooden handled steak knife. Michael Salit, born on 7/21/1943, is currently 77 years old. At this time there is probable cause for the arrest of David Salit for Aggravated Battery on a Person 65 or older (Deadly Weapon), a violation of Florida State Statute 784.08(1)(2a).
