

(Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest)</p> <p>On 3/30/2020 at 2056 hours I was dispatched to 1115 Neoga St. Jupiter FL 33458 in reference to a physical altercation between two females.</p> <p>Upon arrival I made contact with W/F Deborah Hendry (6/12/1961) in the backyard of the residence. She was out of breath, slurring her words, and appeared disheveled as if she had been involved in a fight. There was blood on her hands, and she complained that her front tooth was loose from being struck.</p> <p>I asked her what happened and she told me that she was attacked by multiple individuals for no reason. Hendry stated she was drinking alcohol with her niece at the residence before the altercation occurred.</p> <p>When I attempted to gather more details, D. Hendry became belligerent and uncooperative with my questions. She then requested to have a lawyer present.</p> <p>I then spoke with the complainant, resident of 1115 Neoga St., W/F Kristin P. Sellers (5/23/1991). Sellers had visible scratches on her upper right arm, and a bite mark on her right hand. Sellers told me the following: D. Hendry is her aunt, who lives in the neighborhood. D. Hendry called her earlier in the evening and requested to come over to the residence to help put her daughter, W/F Millie Triola (8/27/2018) to bed.</p> <p>D. Hendry came over, but soon became insulting, and Sellers realized that D. Hendry was very intoxicated. Sellers requested Hendry leave, to which D. Hendry refused. The two were speaking on the deck area, where Sellers again told D. Hendry to leave the residence, and go home. D. Hendry then tried to walk back into the home through the back door accessible from the deck. Sellers stood in the doorway and didn't allow D. Hendry inside. D. Hendry then grabbed Sellers by the hair and began punching her in the head.</p> <p>Sellers defended herself by striking D. Hendry back in the face/head area. The two then ended up on the ground, where Sellers was able to position herself onto of D. Hendry. Sellers pushed D. Hendry's head against the ground several times, as D. Hendry was punching and pulling at her.</p> <p>D. Hendry's husband W/M Troy Hendry (9/19/1968) arrived at the residence during the altercation and witnessed them on the ground fighting. He did not see the fight begin. He assisted in breaking them up, and Sellers called 911. Sellers declined medical attention on scene, completed a sworn statement, and advised she wished to prosecute. Hendry was evaluated by Palm Beach County Fire Rescue on scene, and continued with her belligerent demeanor. Photos of the involved parties injuries were taken and uploaded to Evidence.com</p> <p>Based upon my investigation I determined that D. Hendry was the primary aggressor of the altercation, as she came to Seller's residence intoxicated, and attacked her after being told to leave.</p> <p>D. Hendry was advised she was under arrest. She was placed into handcuffs which were checked for proper spacing and double locked. She was searched incident to arrest by Officer Raleigh with negative results for contraband. While in custody, D. Hendry spontaneously stated that she drank four beers and smoked a joint before going to Seller's house. D. Hendry was brought to the Jupiter Medical Center as a precaution due to her injuries. She was later cleared, and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail without incident.</p> <p>Based upon the above aforementioned facts I find probable cause to charge Deborah Hendry with Florida Statute 784.03(1) SIMPLE BATTERY.</p> <p>Body worn camera was used during this incident. This narrative is a summary of the aforementioned events, and not purported to be verbatim.</p>

On 3/30/2020 at 2056 hours I was dispatched to 1115 Neoga St. Jupiter FL 33458 in reference to a physical altercation between two females.

Upon arrival I made contact with W/F Deborah Hendry (6/12/1961) in the backyard of the residence. She was out of breath, slurring her words, and appeared disheveled as if she had been involved in a fight. There was blood on her hands, and she complained that her front tooth was loose from being struck.

I asked her what happened and she told me that she was attacked by multiple individuals for no reason. Hendry stated she was drinking alcohol with her niece at the residence before the altercation occurred.

When I attempted to gather more details, D. Hendry became belligerent and uncooperative with my questions. She then requested to have a lawyer present.

I then spoke with the complainant, resident of 1115 Neoga St., W/F Kristin P. Sellers (5/23/1991). Sellers had visible scratches on her upper right arm, and a bite mark on her right hand. Sellers told me the following: D. Hendry is her aunt, who lives in the neighborhood. D. Hendry called her earlier in the evening and requested to come over to the residence to help put her daughter, W/F Millie Triola (8/27/2018) to bed.

D. Hendry came over, but soon became insulting, and Sellers realized that D. Hendry was very intoxicated. Sellers requested Hendry leave, to which D. Hendry refused.
