On the **28** day of **February**, **2021** at **01:49** (Specifically include facts constituting cause for arrest.)

On 02/28/2021 at approximately 0104 hours, I responded to the roundabout of S Central Blvd. and Main St. in the Town of Jupiter, Palm Beach County, FL in reference to a motor vehicle crash with unknown injuries. At the time, I was driving an unmarked Jupiter Police Department patrol vehicle (vehicle 1308), I was wearing a JPD uniform clearly identifying myself as a Jupiter Police Officer, and I was wearing my department-issued Axon body camera.

Upon arrival, I observed a silver 2012 Toyota pickup bearing FL tag # 276QXG facing west in the middle of the roundabout. The truck was completely in the bushes so that it made it extremely difficult, if not impossible for anyone to exit the driver door and walk away. The front driver door was opened and a white male, later identified to be Dennis Davis Jr. (05/30/1960) was lying on his back (in the bushes) just outside the driver door. Davis is the registered owner of the vehicle and the keys were still in the ignition. The manner in which Davis was lying in the bushes made it not practical that anyone other than the driver ended up in his position. Officers on scene were able to unlock the truck, turn it off (as it was still in gear), and I entered the passenger side of the vehicle to check Davis' welfare.

I noted Davis had a small dog with him, which was shaking, and sitting quietly in the driver seat, as close to Davis as possible. Davis was conscious and talking with me. It did not appear as though Davis could get himself up under his own power and, due to the potential for internal injuries as a result of the crash, officers on scene advised Davis to stay where he was at until Fire Rescue arrived.

I noted Davis had bloodshot/glassy eyes and very slurred speech. I could smell the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage on Davis' breath which intensified as he spoke to me. Davis attempted several times to reach up to use the steering wheel and bottom of the door frame to get himself up, out of the bushes. I observed a bright pink wristband on

Davis` right wrist which appeared to be the type of wristband used for admission to a bar/nightclub.

During the crash investigation, I determined Davis was traveling northbound on S Central Blvd., approaching the roundabout with Main St. Tire marks in the road indicated Davis was traveling in the outside (right) lane of S Central Blvd. leading up to the roundabout. Instead of completing the right turn to successfully navigate the roundabout Davis traveled straight, struck the curb at the center of the roundabout, and ultimately ended up in the bushes.



When Fire Rescue arrived on scene, I observed Davis was having an extremely difficult time trying to walk. Davis fell several times and Fire Rescue had to physically hold Davis up while he walked to the ambulance. I followed the ambulance to the hospital where Davis was very quickly discharged.

I advised Davis my crash investigation was over and I was starting a criminal DUI investigation. I advised Davis of his Miranda Warnings and confirmed he understood each one. I conducted a post-Miranda interview with Davis in which he advised he was drinking Michelob Ultra brand beers. He stated he drank approximately three beers and ate a burger. Davis advised he was traveling home but could not advise which road he was on. Davis advised on a scale of one (being sober) to ten (being sick), he felt as though he was a two. Davis stated he slightly felt the effects of the alcohol.

Due to my observations of Davis on scene and in the hospital, coupled with the clear judgement issues he had attempting to navigate the roundabout, I placed Davis under arrest for DUI. I did not perform Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks (SFSTs) due to Davis` extreme unsteadiness on his feet I observed on scene (I felt as though subjecting him to SFSTs could potentially cause further, unnecessary injury to him). I secured Davis` right wrist in handcuffs which were secured to the hospital bed.

Since Davis had been discharged quickly, obtaining a breath sample from Davis was both possible and practical. I requested he provide a lawful sample of his breath for the purpose of determining the alcohol content and he refused. I read Davis Implied Consent from a prepared text (excluding the CDL portion of Implied Consent), confirmed his understanding, and again requested he provide a breath sample. Davis refused at 0200 hours.

Based on the aforementioned facts resulting from my investigation, I find Probable Cause exists to charge Dennis Davis Jr. with DUI - Damage to Property pursuant to FSS 316.193(3)(c)(1).
