I then got behind the vehicle in my marked patrol vehicle with overhead lighting equipment. I observed the car to be bearing Florida tag of 'GJNSK54'. I then activated my emergency equipment on my marked patrol vehicle to conduct a traffic stop. The car continued for a short period of time after activating my emergency lights and came to abrupt stop in the roadway on North Dixie Highway just south of 7th Ave. North. The car then moved into a gas station and came to a stop. I then approached the car on the driver's side of the car and observed that there were two occupants in the car. I observed that there was a male driver, later identified as Douglas F. Egan, and a female passenger, Ginette P. Campos. Once the driver's side window opened, I observed an obvious odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the interior of the car. I observed the eyes of Mr. Egan to be red blood shot and glassy. I then introduced myself to the occupants of the car and asked Mr. Egan for his information. Mr. Egan was able to provide his FL DL and the car's registration. I advised Mr. Egan the reason for the stop was for failing to obey the traffic control sign of "NO TURN ON RED". I advised Mr. Egan of my observation of the odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the interior of the car. Mr. Egan stated that he had a few drinks a couple hours ago with some friends. I asked him what he meant by a few drinks and he advised 2-3 alcoholic beverages. I asked him what time he had the drinks and he advised about 00:00 PM. I then asked Mr. Egan to exit the car and he agreed to do so. Once Mr. Egan exited the car, I observed him to have an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from his mouth area and breath. I advised Mr. Egan of this and he stated that it was his breath/mouth that was causing this odor. I then requested Mr. Egan to perform roadside exercises to check for impairment and he agreed. Mr. Egan stated that he did not have any problems with his eyes that were not corrected by glasses. He advised that he does not have any medical or physical problems. He advised that he did not take any medication. 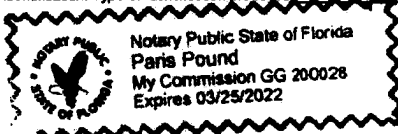

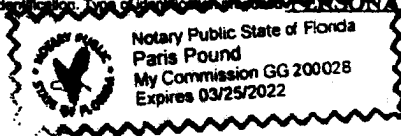
