The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did

The defendant was operating a silver 2004 Honda Odyssey van, Kansas tag 506PHS. The defendant made a turn too short causing the vehicle to enter into the opposing travel lane. The defendant then drove in a manner in which the vehicle was weaving in the travel lane, drifting onto and over painted lane markers numerous times, straddled a painted lane marker several times, and he stopped completely beyond the painted white stop line at steady red traffic light so that the vehicle was into and blocking a clearly marked pedestrian crosswalk. The defendant drove at a visually estimated and patrol car paced speed (TPD unit 5055) of 57 MPH in a properly posted 40 MPH speed limit. A traffic stop was conducted for unlawful speed as well as to check on the driver's welfare to determine if he were sick, tired, or impaired. During the stopping sequence, the defendant's vehicle right side tires drove onto a raised curb and he stopped in the roadway rather than in a number of different available parking lots. The defendant had a distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath. The defendant's eyes were bloodshot, glassy, and watery. The defendant's speech was slurred, and his face was flushed. The front of the defendant's shirt was wet from a liquid, and several open Coors Light 16 ounce beer cans were found within the vehicle (filled with a yellowish liquid determined to be beer). The defendant stated he drank two beers today, and he spontaneously uttered that he was "intoxicated" and that he had too much to drink. The defendant was unsteady exiting the vehicle, he was unsteady on his feet, and he swayed while standing. The defendant agreed to perform Field Sobriety Exercises. The defendant exhibited signs and clues of impairment, and based on a totality of the circumstances he was arrested for DUI. The defendant provided breath samples of .162% BrAC and .165% BrAC. The defendant was positively identified by his Kansas DL.
