PERSONAL CONTACT

DRIVING PATTERN: ACTUAL PHYSICAL CONTROL (PHYSICAL EVIDENCE OR STATEMENTS PUTTING DEF. BEHIND WHEEL OF VEHICLE)

On Saturday, December 5, 2020 at 19:26hrs, I, DUI Investigator Cameron Carver, was at PGA Boulevard and Minsk Gardens Boulevard, in the City of Palm Beach Gardens, within Palm Beach County, Florida. My department issued body worn camera and in-car dash camera was utilized in this investigation and subsequently uploaded to Evidence.com. I was running stationary radar in the westbound lanes of PGA Boulevard when I observed a black Chevrolet Corvette traveling eastbound on PGA Boulevard. I visually estimated the Corvette to be traveling 60mph in a 45mph zone. I also observed the Corvette driving in the right lane ahead of traffic. I got behind the Corvette and saw it bared a Florida license plate IQ87BQ and activated my emergency equipment to order the driver to pull over for the speed violation. The Corvette came to final rest in the parking lot of Anthony's Coal Fire Pizza, located at 2960 PGA BLVD, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33410, straddling the line separating the first two parking spaces. Upon approach to the Corvette, I observed a white male, later identified via Florida driver's license as Edmund Dayan sitting in the driver's seat and the sole occupant.

OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

While speaking with Dayan at the driver's window, I noticed he was shaking and had a cold unopened beer between himself and the center console. While Dayan was looking for his documents, I could smell the strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage coming from the vehicle. I observed his eyes were glassy and bloodshot. When I questioned the odor of alcohol, Dayan admitted to it coming from the open beer bottle in his front passenger seat, which was confirmed after the arrest with the opened Michelob having one quarter of beer remaining. Based on my observations, I requested Dayan exit the vehicle and wait at the rear of his vehicle. While conducting a record check on the vehicle and Dayan's license, as well issue a traffic citation, Dayan became impatient, shouting towards me. Dayan began to walk around my vehicle towards me, at which point I ordered him back to the rear of his vehicle. Upon completing the traffic citation, I re-approached Dayan and he began to raise his voice and again asking for reasoning. I explained the officer safety reasoning, which Dayan immediately changed his demeanor. While explaining the citation to Dayan, the odor of unknown alcohol coming off his breath was strong. I asked Dayan to perform a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tasks which caused Dayan's mood to change again to argumentative and angry.

DRIVER'S STATEMENTS:

When I questioned the odor of alcohol, Dayan admitted to it coming from the open beer bottle in his front passenger seat, which was confirmed after the arrest with the opened Michelob having one quarter of beer remaining. Upon completing the traffic citation, I re-approached Dayan and he began to raise his voice and again demanded why he was waiting outside rather than waiting inside of his vehicle, stating that he's gotten breaks from other officers in the past. Dayan advised he had no medical conditions; had no issues with walking or keeping balance; was wearing a contact in his left eye, but no conditions with his eye. Dayan stated he was on his way to work to lock it up. Dayan conducted the Q&A.

Odor of unknown alcoholic beverage.

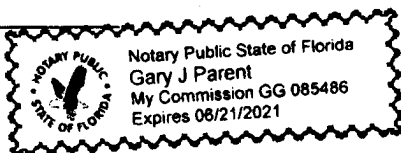

WALK & TURN:

While getting Dayan into the starting position, he started prior to being directed to. The instructions were explained and demonstrated to Dayan. During the instructional phase, Dayan was unable to keep balance, continually stepping out of position. Dayan argued that because he only had his left contact in his eye, he would be unable to perform this task. When I asked him to explain, he was unable to give an articulable reason that having one contact would make it impossible for him to do. I asked Dayan to attempt to perform it after assuring him I would remember his eye condition. After instructions were given and Dayan stating he understood, Dayan started on command and I observed the following clues: Dayan missed heel-to-toe. Dayan stepped off the line on step. Dayan did not turn as instructed and demonstrated. On the return, Dayan missed heel-to-toe on step. Dayan raised his arms more than six inches during the task.

ONE LEG STAND:

The instructions were explained and demonstrated to Dayan, who stated he understood. Upon the command to begin I observed the following clues: Dayan swayed while balancing. Dayan raised his arms more than six inches to maintain balance. Dayan put his foot down multiple times, causing me to stop the task with 13 seconds left on the time. During this task, I also observed Dayan look forward, not at his feet as instructed.

ROMBERG ALPHABET:

The instructions were explained to Dayan, who stated he understood. Upon the command to begin I observed the following clues: Dayan had a visible sway. Dayan incorrectly recited the alphabet, stating A-B-C-D-E-FG HIJL-K-L-MNOP-RST-UV-WXYZ.

FINGER TO NOSE:

The instructions were explained and demonstrated to Dayan, who stated he understood. On the first left, Dayan used the tip of his finger and touched the side of his nose; on the first right, used the tip of his finger and touched the side of his nose; on the second left, used the tip of his finger and touched the tip of his nose; on the second right, used the tip of his finger and touched the tip of his nose; on the third right, used the tip of his finger and touched the side of his nose and on the third left, used the tip of his finger and touched the tip of his nose.

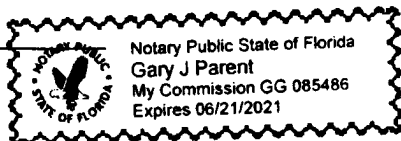

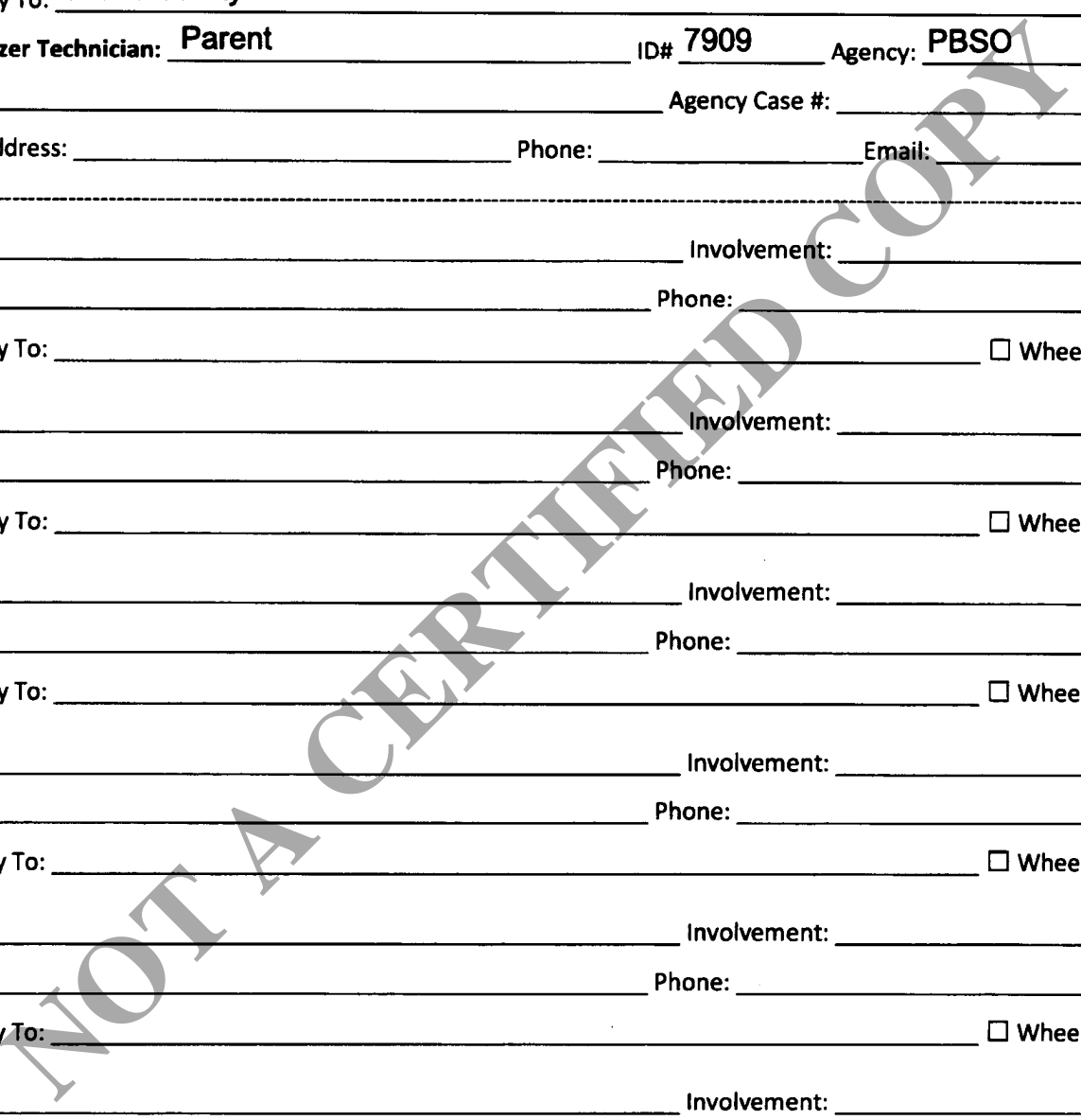
