## Personal Contact

### Driving Pattern

Actual physical control (physical evidence putting the driver behind the wheel)

Miekina Kacper gave a sworn statement, in which he said he was stopped at the red light on Banyan Blvd. and Flagler Dr. Kacper was waiting to make the right turn when a Red Toyota Prius approached his vehicle from the rear. The Prius shifted from the left lane to the right lane and struck the rear of Kacper's vehicle. Kacper observed the driver Edward Green (later identified by Florida Driver's License) in control of the vehicle and behind the driver wheel during the accident and while parking. Kacper stated Green was the sole occupant of the car and no other person exited the vehicle, further more he maintained a visual of the driver and car until police arrived.

### Observation of Driver

The driver was standing outside of his vehicle without any shoes on. The driver appeared to be oblivious as to where the shoes were located. The driver was swaying while he was standing up and talking to me. The driver had slurred speech. The driver had reddened/ glassy eyes.

### Drivers Statements:

The driver was advised that I finished my crash investigation and that I would begin my investigation into driving under the influence. (Post Miranda) The driver stated he had two to three glasses of wine. The driver stated he went to two different restaurants in Palm Beach with his girlfriend. The driver had a cut on his forehead, which he advised happened while he was swimming in the ocean earlier in the morning. The driver stated it was unrelated to the crash.

### Odors:

An odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage could be smelled. The odor continued to grow stronger the more the driver spoke to me.

The driver was instructed to stand with his feet together with his arms at his sides. He was then asked if he could identify the color of the stimulus placed in front of his eyes; in which he advised was blue (which was correct). The driver also physically touched the stimulus with his finger. He was reminded to track the stimulus with his eyes only. He failed to keep his head still while tracking the stimulus. The driver was advised to track the stimulus with his eyes only multiple times. I observed the driver swaying during the instructional and practical portion of this exercise.

### Walk and Turn Task

The driver was walked over to an area that was clear and free from debris. The driver was asked to place his left foot on the line (yellow duct tape) with his right foot directly in front of it and then with his heel touching his toe, then place his arms at his sides and stay in this position while I demonstrated this task. I observed the driver swaying during the instructional portion of this exercise. He could not maintain his balance while listening to the instructions and stepped out of the stance during the demonstration to catch his balance. He started the task before being instructed. On the first set of heel to toe steps he stepped off the line multiple times. He performed the turn other than the way it was demonstrated. On the second set of heel to toe steps, the driver stepped off the line multiple times. The driver needed to stop walking in order to catch his balance. The driver raised his arms in order to assist in his balance.

### One Leg Stand

I had the driver stand with his feet together and hands down at his side as I explained the exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise and he stated he understood the instructions. He could not maintain his balance while listening to the instructions and stepped out of the stance during the demonstration to catch his balance. When told to begin, the driver lifted his right foot off the ground. He put his foot down to regain his balance at numerous times before the thirty seconds had elapsed. I observed the driver swaying during the instructional and practical portion of this exercise. When counting, the driver repeated four, two times.

### Finger To Nose

I had the driver stand with his feet together and hands down at his sides as I explained the exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise and he stated he understood the instructions. The driver demonstrated that he knew his right from his left. I asked the driver to tilt his head back and close his eyes. The sequence performed was: L, R, L, R, R, L. On the first left, the driver missed the tip of his nose with his index finger. The driver failed to return his arms to the starting position for the whole sequence and needed to be reminded each time. I observed the driver swaying during the instructional and practical portion of this exercise.

### Romberg Balance

I had the driver stand with his feet together and hands down at his sides as I explained the exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise and he stated he understood the instructions. The driver stated he knew how long 30 seconds was. I had the driver tilt his head back and close his eyes and estimate the passage of 30 seconds. He advised he finished this exercise at an internal clock of 30 seconds when the actual time was 48 seconds. I observed the driver swaying during this exercise.

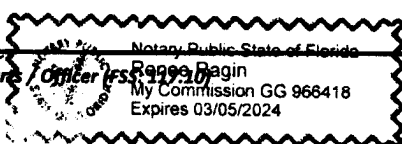

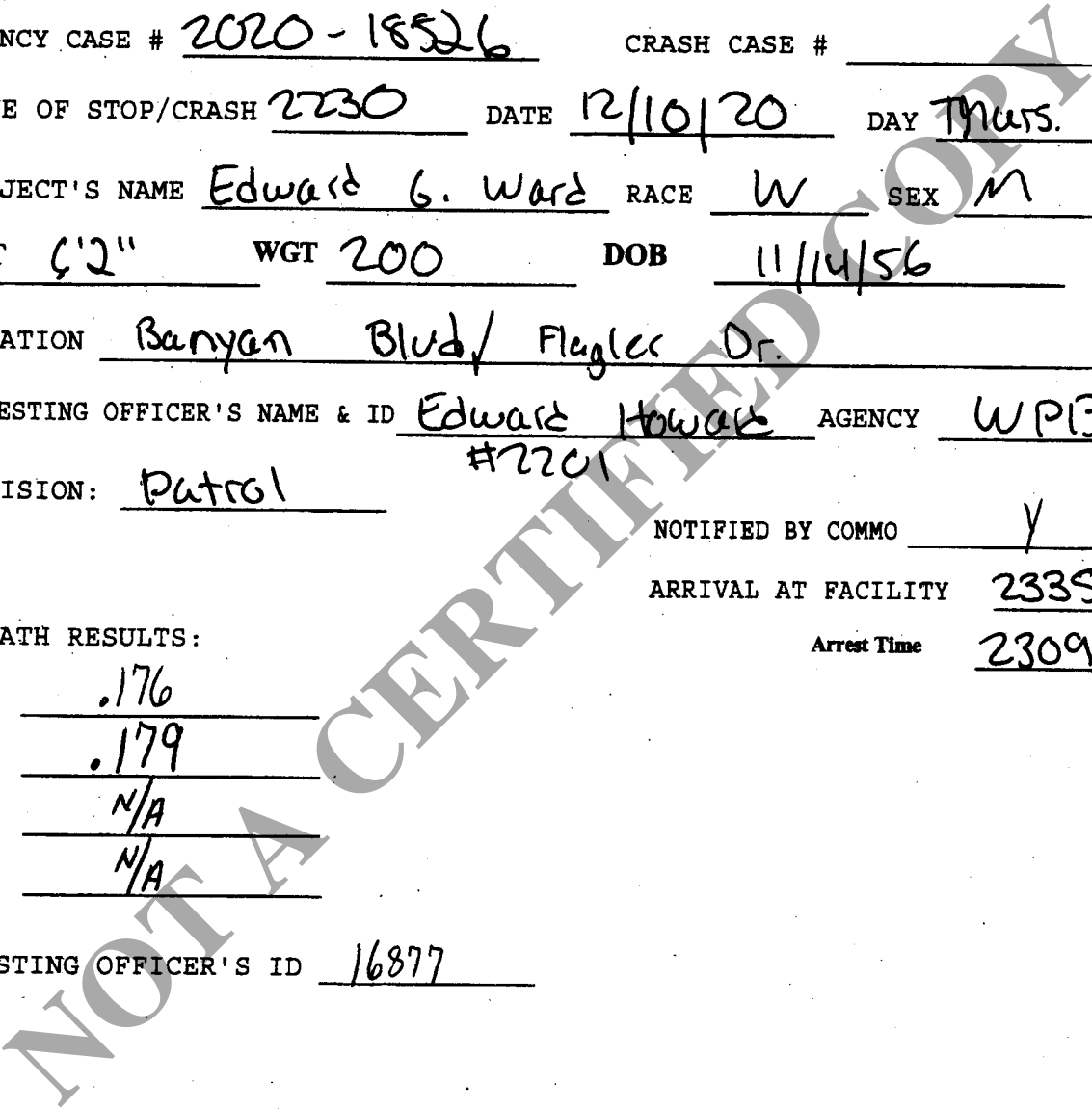
