**Probable Cause**

On Tuesday, October 1st, 2019, I Trooper Sayih #1273 was on routine road patrol in Palm Beach County, Fl. At approximately 05:10 AM I was contacted by the Lake Worth Regional Communications Center (LWRCC) in regards to a vehicle obstructing the roadway located on the southbound Interstate 95 (State Road 9) exit ramp to Glades Rd. (State Road 808) with a white woman with blonde hair standing outside of the vehicle. When I arrived on scene I observed a white in color Cadillac Escalade bearing the Florida Tag, Z60BHZ obstructing the roadway in the outside lane. Approaching the vehicle, I observed it to be unoccupied and full of miscellaneous clothes and items. Once the vehicles tag was run through FCIC/NCIC and confirmed stolen I then observed a white female with blonde hair walking down the exit ramp towards the abandoned vehicle. Coming in contact with the white female who was later identified through her Florida driver license to be Emma Mary Larkin 05/04/1995. Ms. Larkin was read Miranda by Trooper Prado #1851 as she sat in the rear right passenger seat and was asked why the vehicle was in the roadway, who the vehicle belonged to and how did she obtain it to which she advised that it was her friends truck and they had let her borrow it so that she could move her belongings and that she was in the roadway because she had gotten lost and ran out of gas. I was then put into contact through the LWRCC with the owner of the vehicle who initially reported the vehicle stolen. The registered owner was questioned if he knew Ms. Larkin or if he observed any one take his vehicle resulting in him advising me that he did not know who she was nor did he see anybody take his vehicle. The registered owner advised that his vehicle was open and the spare keys were in the center console and that is possibly how the vehicle was taken. Ms. Larkin had access to the vehicle, advised that she was in possession of it by driving it and had her belongings within the vehicle as well. As the tow truck that was initially requested for the vehicle due to it obstructing the roadway and being abandoned arrived, Ms. Larkin started to become agitated stating that we were trying to take her belongings. Ms. Larkin was advised to leave everything in the vehicle due to the tow truck about to load the vehicle on its bed and that she could obtain her stuff after we had gotten the vehicle off of the roadway. Ms. Larkin refused to listen to my instructions and continued to enter the vehicle to pull out different pieces of property that I was unaware if it was hers or the owner of the vehicles, which is the reason why I was not allowing her to obtain anything initially. Ms. Larkin began to get more aggressive and then proceeded to runaway and began resisting as she was caught and being placed under arrest.

- 843.02 Resist Officer without violence
- 318.14.3 Refuse to sign or accept citation

Ms. Larkin was then placed in the back of Trooper J. Pajons vehicle #1139 and transported to the Palm Beach County Jail. Ms. Larkin's belongings were transported to Ft. Lauderdale to her mothers house who we contacted and arraigned for them to meet with us to take possession of her property.
