The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On 8/20/2020 at approximately 1531 hours, I, Sgt. Chester Everett of the Florida Highway Patrol (FHP), was travelling southbound on US-301 south of I-75, in Hillsborough County, Florida, when I observed a vehicle (Honda SUV) blocking the outside lane. I observed another vehicle (witness) behind the SUV, but it was located on the outside shoulder. I activated my emergency lights and pulled behind the vehicles. I exited my vehicle and made contact with the witness. The witness, Ashley Roberge, stated "he is drunk". Ms. Roberge advised she attempted to pass the SUV that was stopped in the lane, but when she started to pass, she observed a man passed out at the wheel. At about the same time I was conversing with Ms. Roberge, the SUV moved from the outside lane to the outside shoulder. I watched as a white male, wearing tan pants and a grey polo shirt, exited the vehicle and walked towards the rear of it. I walked towards the male, later identified as Eric Hagar by his New Hampshire driver license. I observed that Mr. Hagar seemed unsteady on his feet as he walked. As I conversed with Mr. Hagar, I could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath. As I listened to Mr. Hagar talk, I noticed that his speech was slurred. I asked Mr. Hagar to wait at the rear of his vehicle as I removed the keys from the ignition. The SUV was still running at that time. I walked back to where Ms. Roberge was located, and I asked if she would complete a witness statement form and she advised she would. After Ms. Roberge completed the witness form, I advised her she could leave.

I asked Mr. Hagar to stand at the rear of his vehicle. I advised him I was concerned that he might be impaired and that I would like him to do some exercises to make sure he was okay to drive. Mr. Hagar advised he would do the exercises. I asked if he had any injuries and he state no. I asked if he had any recent head injuries and he stated no. The first exercise was the HGN exercise. His performance on the exercise was consistent with that of an impaired person. See FSE Sheet.

After the HGN exercise, I advised Mr. Hagar that there were other exercises I would like him to perform, but the location we were currently located was not safe to do them. Mr. Hagar advised he would go to a different location. We relocated to the CVS at the intersection of US-301 and Bloomingdale.

I advised Mr. Hagar of his rights while he was seated in the front of my patrol car. When I asked if he was willing to answer my questions, he advised no.

The next exercise I had Mr. Hagar perform was the Walk and Turn. Mr. Hagar's performance on that exercise was consistent with that of an impaired person. See FSE sheet.
