The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did
 On February 16th, at approximately 2210hrs, I, Trooper K. Ray, was dispatched to a Crash with Injuries and road block at 50th and Causeway Blvd. Upon my arrival, I was met by Hillsborough County Sheriff's Deputy T. Alloway #252505, who stated to me that the driver of a red Kia crashed into an F350, at the stop light, backed up approximately 100 feet and rammed the truck, twice. Deputy Alloway stated that he removed the key from the ignition to disable the vehicle and left the driver, who was later identified to me as Mr. Eric Lee Schichtl FL DL #S234212650180 was behind the wheel of the red Kia and in physical control of the vehicle. He was cleared by Rescue on scene and refused medical treatment. I had Mr. Schichtl step from the vehicle and into a grassy area so I could clear the roadblock. Mr. Schichtl was not able to walk on his own. He required me to hold him up for him to take steps. Upon entering the grassy area, Mr. Schichtl fell to the ground and remained there while the vehicle was being moved. Because of the intoxicated condition of Mr. Schichtl, he was not able to perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises. Mr. Schichtl had a heavy odor of alcohol coming from his facial area that first smelled from outside his vehicle. He was in disarray and could not walk. I asked Ms. Schichtl if he would perform field sobriety of which he stated he could not and stated, 'fuck you'. I placed Mr. Schichtl under arrest approximately 2225hrs and placed him into the back of my patrol vehicle. Mr. Schichtl had a large sum of cash in the console of his vehicle and right front pocket all of which was accounted for with Dep. Alloway as witness, placed into a manila envelope and stored in my front passenger seat along with his cell phone. On the way to the county jail, Mr. Schichtl urinated on himself. At the Central Breath Test Room, Mr. Schichtl agreed to provide a breath sample. He blew a .319 and a .311. Within protocol of jail medical staff, Mr. Schichtl was cleared by the duty Nurse Practitioner because of his extremely high level of BAC. Mr. Schichtl was then booked into Hillsborough County Jail without further incident.
