The driver was instructed to stand with his feet together with his arms at his sides. He was reminded to track the stimulus with his eyes only. I observed the driver slightly swaying during the instructional and practical portion of this exercise.

Walk and Turn Task

The driver was asked to place his left foot on the line (solid gray line on sidewalk) with his right foot directly in front of it with his heel touching his toe, then place his arms at his sides and stay in this position while I demonstrated this task. I observed the driver swaying during the instructional portion of this exercise. He could not maintain his balance while listening to the instructions and stepped out of the stance during the demonstration to catch his balance once. The driver began before being told to start. The driver missed each and every step heel to toe and incorrectly did the turn.

One Leg Stand

I had the driver stand with his feet together and hands down at his side as I explained the exercise. I explained and demonstrated the exercise and he stated he understood the instructions. I observed the driver swaying during the instructional portion of this exercise. The driver failed to count out loud as instructed. The driver was reminded to do so, and failed to continue counting when he put his foot down, which was every few seconds.

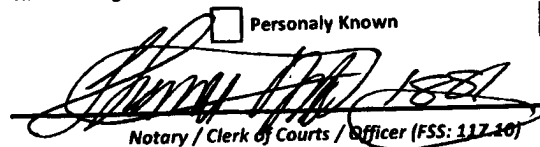

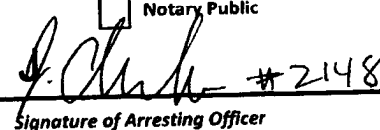
