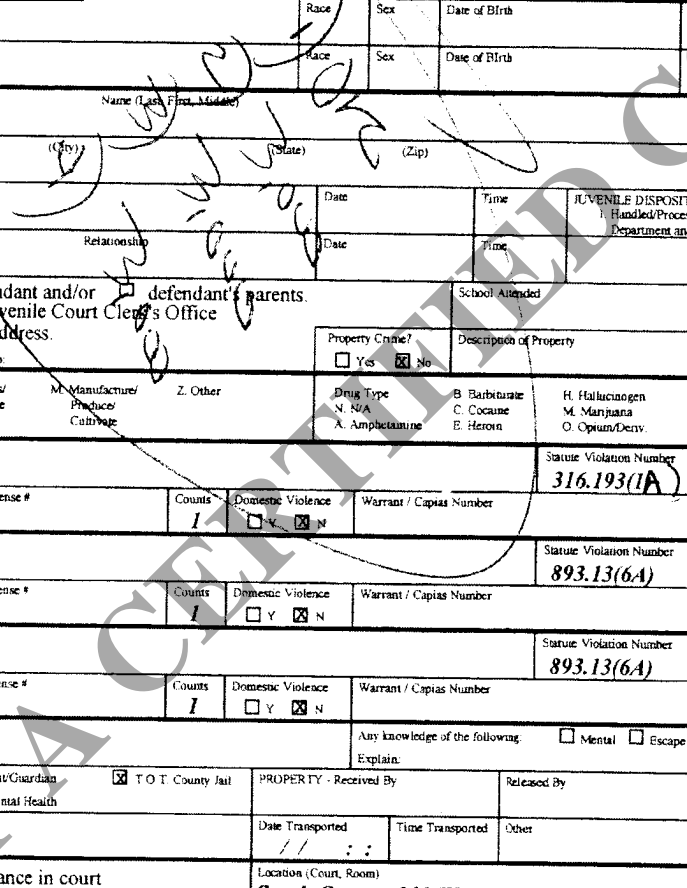



Camino Real (Boca Raton Resort) in reference to a male passed out in a 2009 black Mercedes E63 bearing FL tag XF241 in the parking lot. Upon my arrival BRFD knocked on the driver's window and woke up W/M Evan Grayson who was passed out. Grayson advised that he had fallen asleep and had spent the night in his vehicle in the parking lot due to him wanting to avoid his mother.</p> <p>I observed a large glass bong between Grayson's feet on the driver's side floorboard. I asked Grayson to step out of the vehicle and I asked him for consent to search his person which he provided. I then searched his person and found a capped syringe in his front right pocket. I found four small plastic baggies in his back-right pocket and one had a small amount of a white powdery substance inside of it. I read Grayson his constitutional rights from a preprinted card which he advised that he understood and agreed to speak with me. Grayson advised that the baggies were his and that he had thrown them in his pocket on the way out of his house.</p> <p>It should be noted that I observed Grayson in actual physical control of the vehicle. When I initially contacted Grayson he was in the driver's seat with the engine off. While I was speaking with him, he started the engine at which point he was advised to turn the vehicle off. I observed that Grayson's pupils were pinpoint, his eyes were bloodshot, he was fidgety, he was sweating, and he appeared sluggish and lethargic. I then began a DUI investigation and asked Grayson if he was willing to submit to the standard field sobriety tasks which he agreed. Grayson advised that he has a right hip injury but was able to walk. Grayson advised that he had previously taken Xanax, smoked THC, and benzodiazepines. Grayson advised that he last took the drugs around when the sun set the night before. Grayson advised that he uses the narcotics for pain management for a hip injury.</p>



<p>The first task was the walk and turn. I instructed and demonstrated the task to Grayson which he advised that he understood. Grayson stepped off the line, missed heel to toe, used his arms to balance, and made an improper turn. The second task was the one leg stand. I instructed and demonstrated the task to Grayson which he advised that he understood. Grayson swayed, used his arms to balance, put his right foot down early, and then used his left foot to continue with the task.</p> <p>The third task was the Romberg alphabet. Grayson swayed while completing the alphabet. The fourth task was the finger to nose. Grayson did not bring his finger down during the task and touched the tip of his nose with the middle part of his index finger. Based on my observations I placed Grayson under arrest for DUI. Grayson was transported to PBSO's BAT facility where I conducted the 20-minute observation period. PBSO BAT Technician J. Bell ID#8656 operated the Intoxilyzer 8000. Grayson provided two breath samples of .000.</p> <p>I then requested Grayson provide a urine sample. I read Grayson his implied consent warnings which he understood, and he initially agreed to provide a urine sample. Grayson later advised that he wanted to invoke his 5th amendment rights and refused to provide a sample. Grayson stated that he understood his implied consent warnings and again refused to provide a urine sample. Grayson was then issued a refusal at 1126 hours.</p> <p>Officer Madotta searched Grayson's vehicle and located a small white capsule on the driver's floorboard which was sent to PBSO's lab for testing. Officer Madotta located a small plastic baggie full of an unknown substance in Grayson's wallet which was sent to PBSO's lab for testing. Officer Madotta located 9 broken pieces of alprazolam pills (1.1 grams) in a black container in a briefcase in the back seat. Grayson advised that they were his and that he had a prescription for it, however he was unable to provide a prescription for it.</p> <p>Officer Madotta also located a small jar of THC oil which weighed 116 grams including packaging in the same briefcase. Grayson advised that he has a medical marijuana card and prescription for it, however he was unable to provide the prescription or medical marijuana card. I had BRPD Communications check the medical marijuana card database and was advised that he did not have a card. Officer Madotta tested the small plastic baggie that I found in his back-right pocket with a department issued test kit and it tested positive for cocaine. The baggie weighed 0.1 grams with packaging. Officer Madotta tested the THC with a department issued test kit and it tested positive for THC. Officer Madotta contacted poison control and spoke with Tess, who advised that with the markings on the pill she was able to verify that the pills are alprazolam, a schedule four substance.</p> <p>Based on my investigation I am charging Grayson with DUI in violation of F.S.S. 316.193(1), possession of cocaine in violation of 893.13(6A), possession of alprazolam</p>
