The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On 05/02/20 at approximately 0015 hrs the defendant was observed driving a black Honda Civic bearing FL TAG LBVT12 which registration had expired in March of 2020 via a DHSMV check which also showed that the defendant's license was suspended. A traffic stop was conducted for the above stated offenses, she was given a verbal warning for the traffic offenses, after that I turned off all emergency equipment and she was told she was "good to go." I then engaged her in casual conversation and asked her if I could search her vehicle for any drugs or guns. She stated that I could search the vehicle and the only thing that I would find is a "little bit of weed" in a jewelry box in her purse along with a Xanax. I then asked her if she meant marijuana and she stated yes, I then asked her if she had a medical marijuana card to which she said no.

I then conducted a search of the vehicle and during the search of the defendants purse I located the marijuana(.9g) in the jewelry box in her purse along with a half pill of Xanax. Also in the purse was a blue wallet which contained three suspected ecstasy pills (2.2g). The three pills of ecstasy were field tested and were positive, The suspected marijuana was field tested utilizing two separate departmentally issued test kits to determine if the substance was legal hemp or illegal cannabis. The first field test kit (Duquenois-Levine Field Reagent Test manufactured by Lynn Peavey) was utilized to determine if the suspected cannabis contained THC (tetrahydrocannabinol).

I placed a small sample in the ampoule and broke the first container of liquid. I then waited 60 seconds and broke the second container of liquid. The chemicals mixed with the sample turned from clear to a purpleish color which for this tester equates a positive result for the presence of THC.

Based on the results of the first field reagent test, I conducted the second test which was a cannabis typification field reagent test (4-AP / "Swiss" test manufactured by Syndicate Chemistry). This test was conducted to verify the THC concentration exceeded 1% (over .4% is a criminal violation). I placed another small sample in the ampoule and broke the liquid capsule inside. I then waited 1 minute. The clear liquid turned to blue which for this tester is a positive result for a THC concentration exceeding 1% (the color pink would have equated a negative result).

The defendant was positively identified via DHSMV photo.
