



Upon arrival contact was made with the defendant, Hector Laguna, who was identified by a wheel witness as being the driver of a vehicle involved in a motor vehicle crash. Laguna seated on the side of the roadway in the shaded grass area. When asked to relocate to the front of my marked police vehicle, Laguna attempted to walk to the directed area but had trouble maintaining his balance. At that time, his eyes were also glossy, and his speech was slurred. I informed Laguna that the traffic crash portion had concluded and that I would now be conducting a DUI investigation, he replied that he understood. I asked Laguna where he had been coming from and he stated he was leaving a Walgreens off of Palmetto in the city of Deerfield Beach. It should be noted, at this time, our current location was already south of Palmetto Rd in the City of Boca Raton, and Deerfield Beach is south of Boca Raton. Laguna also mentioned he had two small bottles of an alcohol he knew to be called "99," later saying that they were "shots" he purchased from the Walgreens around 1000 hours earlier this morning. The accident Laguna was involved in occurred at 1533 hours. He informed me that he did not have any injuries or ailments that would prevent him from conducting physical activity or daily task, even mentioning that he does a lot of climbing and walking on rough surfaces at his place of work.</p> <p>At this point, I requested that he perform the standard field sobriety tasks to dispel my alarm of driving while impaired. Laguna provided consent and I proceeded with the standard field sobriety tasks. I performed and demonstrated each task before Laguna attempted them.</p> <p>The first test administered was the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus. After stating he understood the instructions, I began the test. During the test, I observed equal tracking and what appeared to be equal pupil size present in both eyes. I also observed smooth pursuit. I observed distinct and sustained nystagmus prior to 45 degrees and</p>



<p>nystagmus at maximum deviation. It should be noted he exhibited orbital sway, requiring additional officers on scene to assist to prevent him from falling to the side. During the test, Laguna had to be reminded to refrain from moving his head from side to side as he followed the tip of my pen.</p> <p>The second task was the Walk and Turn. After stating he understood the instructions and beginning the task, Laguna did not maintain the starting position, losing balance several times. Laguna did not maintain balance on the line and could not keep his arms to his side while the instructions were being explained. Once he was instructed to begin, each step Laguna took he had difficulty maintaining balance, several times requiring assistance from officers to remain upright. Upon reaching step 6, due to his consistent inability to balance himself, nearly falling over several times, Laguna was instructed to stop performing the Walk and Turn. It is to be noted that while performing those 6 steps, Laguna stepped off the line four times.</p> <p>The Third task was the One Leg Stand. After verbally agreeing that he understood the instructions, Laguna was instructed to begin the test. Once begun, Laguna elevated his right foot, placing it against his left leg and appearing to rest it on his left knee. He failed to extend his foot in an outward position as demonstrated prior to the test. He also failed to count out loud as instructed. During the test, even while resting his right foot on his left leg, he lost balance six times which caused him to drop his foot each time for balance. The task was then concluded at the end of a thirty second timer.</p> <p>Prior to beginning the standard field sobriety tasks Ofc. Crawford spoke with a witness who observed Laguna in full physical control of a white in color Honda Accord (FL tag BRII53), seated behind the wheel of the driver's seat. The other occupants involved in the accident were transported to Boca Raton Regional Hospital for possible minor injuries.</p> <p>Based on my investigation, I placed Laguna under arrest for DUI per F.S.S. 316.193(3A), subsequently being transported to the Palm Beach Sherriff's Office Jail for utilization of the breathalyzer facility. After conducting my 20-minute observation, Breath Tech Operator S. Owen #3184 conducted the Intoxilyzer 8000, and Laguna provided the breath samples of .154 and .147.</p> <p>Laguna was read his Constitutional warnings and stated he would speak to me without an attorney present. He stated that around 1300-1400 hours, while in the City of Deerfield Beach he chugged two shots of an alcohol known to him as "99." He believed the date to be 04/26/2021 and was not aware of the current time of day. Laguna admitted to currently still feeling the effects of the alcohol and when asked his he was currently intoxicated, he then shrugged his shoulders and replied "barely."</p>
