The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did:

On the above-listed date and time, Deputy Widener #258679, arrived at the above-listed location in reference to a fight call for service. Upon arrival, Deputy Widener observed multiple people on the street. Deputy Widener was advised that the defendant who was in a black Mazda Tribune bearing Florida tag: NHFW46, was involved in a verbal altercation with his family. Deputy Widener observed the defendant within the vehicle in the driver's seat. Deputy Widener asked the defendant to exit the vehicle to conduct her investigation. Upon exiting the vehicle, Deputy Widener observed the defendant was unsteady on his feet, had slurred speech, and a distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage was emanating from his breath. The Affiant responded to the scene, the Affiant observed the defendant was leaning against the vehicle and was unsteady on his feet. The defendant also had slurred speech, and a distinct odor of an alcoholic beverage was emanating from his breath. Affiant requested the defendant to perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSEs), which the defendant agreed to perform. During the exercises, the defendant showed multiple signs of impairment and was subsequently arrested for DUI. The defendant agreed to provide a lawful breath sample to determine his breath alcohol content (BrAC). After a proper 20 minute observation period was conducted, the defendant provided two lawful samples of his breath and they are as follows: First BrAC sample (.137): Second BrAC sample (.144) The defendant received a Uniform Traffic Citation #A851N0E, which reflects the DUI charge. The defendant verbally identified himself.
