Road 9), south of Woolbright Road. I observed a silver Honda van in the inside center lane traveling at slow rates of speed. Other vehicles were forced to move from behind the vehicle in order to travel at the speed limit. I placed my patrol vehicle behind the Honda van and turned on my state issued, in-vehicle camera. The Honda van failed to maintain it's lane and almost collided with a passenger car in the center lane. At approximately 1:48 AM, I activated my patrol vehicle lights and sirens to initiate a traffic stop. The Honda was slow to stop and almost collided with another vehicle in the center lane before coming to a stop in the right paved shoulder.

As I approached the vehicle, the driver was attempting to put his window up. I told him not to do that and put the window back down. I made contact with the driver, who was identified by his Kentucky driver's license (V20-310-133) as HIEN NGOC VU. I immediately asked VU if he was okay. VU stated he did not understand English and he spoke Vietnamese. During this initial contact, I observed VU had bloodshot, glossy eyes, and there was a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emitting from his mouth area.

The Lake Worth Regional Communication Center (LWRCC) was unable to locate a Vietnamese translator. For the remainder of the traffic stop, I used Google Translate to translate from English to Vietnamese and made sure to ask if VU understood everything he was reading during every translation.

I asked VU if he could step out of the vehicle. I asked VU if he had any medical conditions and he stated he did not. I asked VU where he was coming from, he stated a family party. I asked VU if he had anything to drink, he said one beer. I asked VU if he would be willing to perform Field Sobriety Tasks, he stated he would. I escorted VU to the Seven Eleven gas station on Woolbright Road, east of Interstate 95, for safety purposes. During the contact outside of the vehicle, I was still able to smell a strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage.

I asked VU if he wore contacts or glasses, he stated he did not. I asked VU if he was in a crash today, he stated he was not. I asked VU if he had any medical conditions or injuries, including any injuries to legs or arms, that would affect any of

the tasks, he stated he did not. I asked VU to stand in front of my patrol vehicle so I can capture all the tasks on my state issued in-vehicle camera. The area was clear of debris and all exercises were explained and demonstrated before VU performed them in a well light area from my patrol car takedown lights and the parking lot lights. The following exercises and clues were performed and observed:

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN):

I asked VU if he could see the light on my stimulus, he stated he could. VU was also able to verify the stimulus light was "Red". I checked for equal pupil size and equal tracking.

I observed the following during HGN:

Left eye- Lack of Smooth Pursuit

Right eye- Lack of Smooth Pursuit

Left eye- Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation

Right eye- Distinct and Sustained Nystagmus at Maximum Deviation

I also observed VU failed to follow directions multiple times when asked to keep his eyes on the light and follow the light. Multiple times VU was unable to follow the stimulus with his eyes.

Walk and Turn (WAT):

VU started the exercise too early. VU used his arms to balance. VU made an incorrect turn. VU missed the heel-to-toe step on the 3rd, 4th, 6th, and 8th step during the first set of steps and then the 6th, 7th, and 8th step on the second set of steps. VU also only took eight steps during the first and second set of steps.

One Leg Stand (OLS):

I used the stopwatch on my watch to time the task for 30 seconds.

VU put his foot down, hopped multiple times, swayed, and raised his arms for balance multiple times.

I also observed VU was unable to count even though he stated he understood the

instructions. VU did not attempt to count in English or Vietnamese, he stood silently.

Based upon the totality of circumstances and my training and experience, I placed HIEN NGOC VU under arrest at approximately 2:23 AM for Driving Under the Influence of an unknown alcoholic beverage or unknown chemical or controlled substance. VU was then placed in restraints which were secured, double-locked, and checked for proper tightness for his security and mine. I did not read VU his Miranda Warnings due to the language barrier, and I did not ask VU any incriminating questions.

Trooper Jerome Grant released the property, with VU's permission, to VU's girlfriend.

I conducted a 20-minute observation period of VU while in the Breath Testing Center. During this observation period, VU did not put anything in his mouth or regurgitate. While in the testing room I requested that VU submit to a breath test in order to determine the alcohol content. VU stated he did not understand. I explained the breath test to VU and he still was not sure if he should submit. At this time, I read VU the Florida implied consent. VU then agreed to the breath test. The results were as follows:

Breath sample 1: .046 g/210L
Breath sample 2: .044 g/210L

I then asked VU for a urine sample. VU stated he did not understand. I explained I was requesting for him to urinate into a cup in order to test for substances other than alcohol. VU refused.

All events occurred in Palm Beach County, Florida.

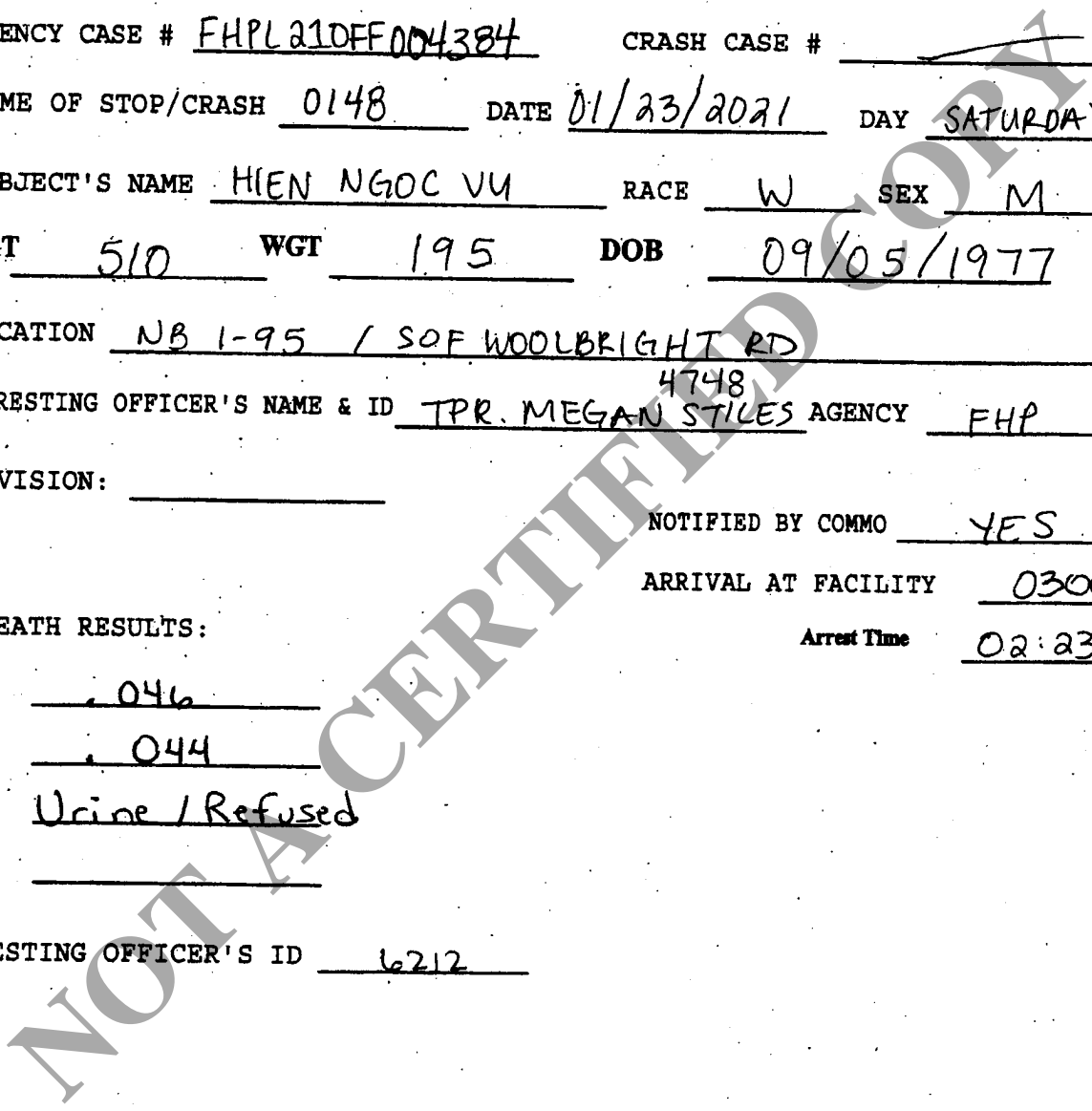
