The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did On 12/29/2020, at approximately 2027 hours, deputies were dispatched 16121 Dale Mabry Hwy N (Home Depot) in Tampa, FL in reference to a person down call for service. The comments of the call stated "LE HIT VEH IN PLOT AND HAVING A SEIZURE//NOT MOVING." Deputy E. Rieger ABN 254141 observed a black Nissan NC tag DAX4209 (VIN:KNMAT2MT8FP501116) in the parking lot of the above listed location blocking a travel lane. Deputy Rieger observed the defendant unconscious in the driver seat and the sole occupant of the vehicle. Deputy Rieger noted that the vehicle was on and the keys were in the ignition turned to the "on" position. Deputy Rieger and members of the Hillsborough County Fire Rescue were able to wake the defendant by knocking on the window and announcing "Sheriff's Office." When the defendant regained consciousness, Deputy Rieger observed indicators of impairment during her interaction with the defendant. Affiant responded to the scene, observed the defendant to have constricted pupils, she was on unsteady on her feet, she had difficulty keeping her eyes open, and was lethargic in her movements. Affiant requested the defendant perform Standard Field Sobriety Exercises (SFSES) which the defendant agreed to perform. During the SFSEs, the defendant showed multiple signs of impairment and was subsequently arrested for DUI. The defendant refused to provide a lawful sample of her urine to determine the presence of chemical and/or controlled substances. Affiant read Implied Consent to the defendant in room 1 of Central Breath Testing, she understood and replied "No." The defendant was identified via DAVID photo.
