D.U.I. PROBABLE CAUSE AFFIDAVIT

ON THE 09 DAY OF January 2020 AT 7:29 A.M. P.M.

PERSONAL CONTACT/DRIVING PATTERN/OBSERVATION OF DRIVER:

I responded to 646 Oak St. in reference to a Vehicle versus a Tree Crash. This incident occurred within the City of Boynton Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida. Caller advised that she personally knew the driver as "Holly" and that she appeared to be under the influence. Caller advised she assisted Holly into her residence, 652 Oak St.

Upon arrival I observed a Gray Honda Accord bearing Florida tag Y21RUX in the front yard of 646 Oak St facing south. The front of the vehicle was in contact with a medium size oak tree. There was also an approximate 3 foot white wooden "4 sale" on the ground, near the vehicle. The front left corner of the vehicle had white paint transfer that appeared that came from the wooden post. There was no other damage seen at the time. The vehicle was unoccupied and the doors were locked. The owner of the residence was not present at the time but was being contacted by neighbors.

I then made contact with Officer Cardenas who pointed out the witnesses. I made contact W/F Pierce, Elizabeth (03/20/64). Pierce advised that she resides at 637 Oak St, which is across the street from 646 Oak St. Pierce advised that while speaking with a neighbor, W/M Coldren, Randy (06/09/54), in front of her residence Coldren pointed out the Honda and the fact that it was in contact with the tree. Pierce advised that she recognized the vehicle to be her neighbor's Holly vehicle. Pierce advised that when she went to investigate she could hear a voice coming from the opened driver's door to the vehicle. Pierce advised Holly (W/F Hiles, Holly 11/20/76) was sitting in the driver seat to the vehicle, crying and repeating "my babies". Pierce advised that Hiles' phone was on her lap and on the screen had "911" on it. The phone appeared to be dialing out and as Pierce announced herself to Hiles, Hiles hung up the phone. Pierce advised seconds later the phone began to ring and once answered Pierce was speaking with Boynton Beach Police dispatch. At that moment is when Pierce reported the crash. Once off the phone, Pierce called out to Coldren and both assisted Hiles into her (Hiles') residence. Pierce advised that as she assisted Hiles out of the vehicle that she closed the door behind them. Pierce advised that Hiles did not "look right" and that she may have appeared to be under the influence of something. Pierce advised that Hiles was very unstable and her speech was slurred and unintelligible at times. Pierce advised there was no one else in the vehicle. Pierce advised that she did not recall if the vehicle's engine was on and the whereabouts of the key fob. See Pierce's BWC statement for further.

I then made contact with Coldren. Coldren advised that upon arriving home he quickly noticed the location of the Honda and was unsure if it was occupied or not. Coldren advised that she observed Pierce outside of her residence so therefore he informed her of his observations. Coldren confirmed that he did assist Pierce with helping Hiles into her residence but he did not observe Hiles inside the vehicle. Coldren confirmed that Hiles was very unstable on her feet. See Coldren's BWC statement for further.

I then made contact with Officer Eichorst and Hiles inside the residence. Hiles was laying on the couch in the living room, with her eyes close. Officer Eichorst advised that upon her arrival the Honda was at its location and Hiles was inside her residence alone. Officer Eichorst advised that when making contact with Hiles, Hiles was laying on the couch in the same condition I saw her in. Officer Eichorst advised that while conducting her investigation Hiles was very unstable and had fallen into the ground. Officer Eichorst advised that Hiles' speech was slurred and her eyes were bloodshot/glassy. Officer Eichorst advised that Hiles exhibited signs of impairment. See Officer Eichorst's supplement for further.

I then checked on Hiles' welfare, which she stated that's he was okay. Hiles did not know the purpose for police present and was no aware of any accident involving her vehicle. While trying to explain the allegations to Hiles she advised that she was to see her vehicle. While trying to get up from the couch Hiles was very unstable and requested for our assistance to help her out. Officer Eichorst and I had to assist Hiles outside of the residence. Once outside Hiles was shocked of the location of her vehicle and was unaware on how it got there. While speaking with Hiles, her speech was very slurred and unintelligible at times. A strong odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage emanating from her breath; which intensified as she spoke. Hiles advised that she doesn't recall what had happened but only recalled driving home from the liquor store. Hiles appeared very confused and denied having any medical conditions and/or injuries. Hiles advised that the key fob to her vehicle was currently inside the residence but when she operates the vehicle she normally places them in the center console area. Officers had to support Hiles the entire time at this point and if not Hiles would have fallen down. Hiles explained that she was going through depression due to her twin brother passing away a couple of years again.

I then made contact with Hiles' husband, W/M Ernst, Dean (02/28/69). Ernst advised when he arrived home officers were already on scene. Ernst explained that Hiles has been drinking all day. Ernst advised that Hiles needs to go to therapy/consoling/ detox. He had contacted numerous locations today to try to assist her but she refused to go. Ernst advised that prior to him leaving the residence hours prior, he took the main keys to her Honda and advised Hiles that she not go anywhere in the condition that she was in. Apparently Hiles had located her spare key to her Honda and utilized it to go to the liquor store. Ernst advised that Hiles needed help for her alcohol addiction. Ernst was able to unlock the

Honda and had located the spare key fob in the center console, in front of the gear shifter. See Ernst's BWC statement for further.

Officer Eichorst and I then escorted Hiles to the front of my fully marked patrol vehicle. I reviewed the allegations to Hiles, which she stated that she understood. I then advised Hiles that I've concluded my crash investigation and that I was now conducting a DUI investigation. Hiles appeared to be confused and emotional. I then read Hiles' her Miranda Warnings, which she stated that she understood. Hiles was very affectionate, as she continued to rub my arm and hand as I was supporting her from falling. While trying to ascertain the amount of alcohol she had consumed, Hiles advised that she was going back inside her residence. After being told numerous times that she was not free to leave and that a criminal investigation was being conducted she was very persistent that she was going back into her residence. Based on my investigation at this point I requested Hiles to submit to Series of Standardized Field Sobriety Task, which she eventually stated that she understood. I then advised Hiles of her Taylor Warnings, which she eventually advised that she understood. I then requested a second time which Hiles refused. At that time Hiles was placed into custody under suspicion of DUI (D/L and Spaced).

While on scene the owner of 646 Oak St arrived. W/M Blair, Randall (02/18/63) advised that he was contacted by Ernst about the incident. Blair advised that the realtor sign in front of residence was properly erected when he left his residence earlier in the day. Blair confirmed that there was no other damage observed on his property at the time. Blair identified the Honda to belonging to Hiles; his direct neighbor to the east.

Hiles was then placed in the back seat of my vehicle and transported to the Palm Beach County BAT facility. I arrived at the facility at 2103hrs, started my 20 minutes observations at 2108hrs and completed it at 2128hrs. During the observation Hiles advised that she was drinking so much because she was depress with her brother passing away. Upon completion I requested Hiles to provide a sample of her breath to determine the alcohol content, which she refused. I then advised Hiles of Implied Consent, which she stated that she understood and refused again to provide a breath sample. I then re-read Hiles her Miranda Warnings, which she stated that she understood. Hiles completed partial of the Q & As. During the questioning Hiles advised that she had been drinking vodka since the day before yesterday (01/07).

Officer Eichorst later responded to the liquor store Hiles traveled to, Boynton Wine and Spirits (1550 N. Federal Highway). Clerk advised and provided a copy of a receipt of Hiles transaction time stamped at 1631hrs. Clerk advised that Hiles purchased 8 New Amsterdam mini Vodka bottles.

Based on the above facts I've established Probable Cause to arrest Hiles with 1M count of DUI W/ Property Damage pursuant with F.S.S. 316.193.3.C.1. Due to the fact that Hiles was involved in crash she was transported to a local hospital for medical clearance and later TOT PBCJ.

Copy of the in-car video and crime scene photos were placed into the Boynton Beach Police Evidence Department. Incident was captured via BWC as well. Hiles' vehicle was removed from scene by Ernst.

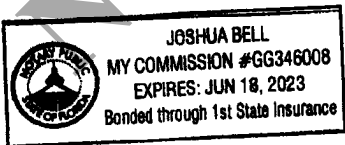

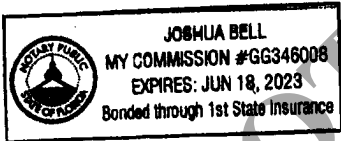
