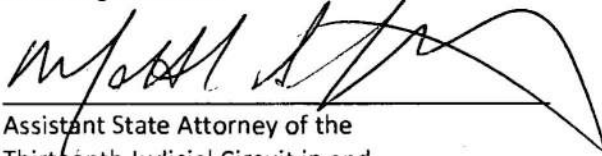

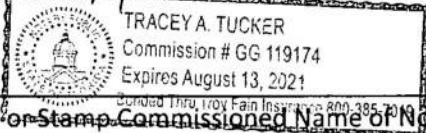

The undersigned swears there are reasonable grounds to believe that the above named defendant in Hillsborough County, Florida, did
 On 06/25/2020, at approximately 1350 hours, while driving westbound on Countryway Bl, towards Race Track Rd, the defendant slowed in front of the victim, to approximately 15 mph. The victim went around the defendant and pulled up to the stop light at Countryway Bl and Racetrack Rd. The defendant then pulled alongside the passenger side of the victim's vehicle and threw an unidentified object at it. The victim then followed the defendant northbound on Race Track Rd, towards Ecclesia Dr., in an attempt to take a photograph of the defendant's vehicle and license tag. Once the victim was able to obtain the photograph she made a U-turn and headed southbound on Race Track Rd. The defendant followed the victim and once at the intersection of Race Track Rd and Countryway Bl, the defendant pulled up beside her, showed her a small, black handgun and waived it around while looking directly at her. The victim stated that this put her in fear for her life and those of her two three year old twins. The victim identified the defendant as the individual that followed her and displayed his handgun to her. The defendant was identified via his FL DL.
