On June 25, 2020 at approximately 4:16 pm, I was informed by the Lake Worth Regional Communications Center (LWRCC) or Dispatch to Be On The Look Out (BOLO) for a vehicle traveling northbound on Interstate 95 (State Road 9) from Linton Blvd (State Road 782). The BOLO was for a dark in color Mazda 6 driving all over the road, swerving, driving from lane to lane at various rates of speed, almost crashing into vehicles. I was advised by dispatch a caller was traveling behind the vehicle. The caller informed Dispatch the dark in color Mazda collided with a vehicle and continued traveling northbound. The caller also informed the dark in color Mazda collided with the concrete wall barrier and continued traveling northbound. The Mazda eventually was intercepted by multiple vehicles and the good Samaritan were able to stop the vehicle northbound on Interstate 95 just north of Atlantic Ave. The driver of the Mazda was described as a white male, bald approximately 5'08. Upon my arrival I observed several vehicles blocking the inside lane, around the dark in color Mazda. The Mazda was located in between the left inside lane and the left inside shoulder. I also observed the driver of the Mazda outside his vehicle. I asked the driver of the Mazda why he continued driving after colliding with a vehicle. The driver seemed confused and disoriented, he stated he had not collided with anything. A few minutes later the driver of the Mazda stated he did not stop after the collision because traffic was heavy. The driver was detained and placed in the back of my marked FHP #1438 vehicle. I then asked all the other drivers to move their vehicles to the left shoulder to unblock the left inside lane. All vehicle were moved to the left inside shoulder including the dark in color Mazda. The driver of the Mazda was escorted to the left side of my patrol vehicle and Trooper Menard ID#509 stayed with him. I then initiated my crash investigation. The driver of the dark in color Mazda bearing Florida tag "PCHA70" was identified by his Florida driver's license

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#H530439754200 as Jad Yusef Hamideh. Trooper Jean Baptiste ID#1570 and Sergeant Alarcon ID#350 also arrived on scene to assist. Trooper Jean Baptiste made contact with the witnesses and collected several witnesses statements. The ambulance arrived, Mr. Hamideh was checked by the medics and was cleared on scene. At approximately 4:53 pm I informed Mr. Hamideh I had concluded my crash investigation and I was switching to a criminal investigation. I explained to Mr. Hamideh I suspect he was driving under the influence based on the totality of the circumstances. I read Mr. Hamideh his Miranda rights and initiated my investigation. Mr. Hamideh stated he understood and he was willing to speak to us. I asked Mr. Hamideh to perform standardized field sobriety exercises, Mr. Hamideh agreed to perform exercises. Prior to performing the exercises I confirmed that he did not have any medical conditions or injuries. Each exercise was explained and demonstrated prior to Mr. Hamideh attempting to perform the exercises. The results of those exercises are summarized below.

Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus Exercise

- While performing the HGN Mr. Hamideh lost his balance and we had to start all over.
- Constricted pupils

Walk and Turn Exercise (an imaginary line was used)

- Lost his balance
- Missed heel to toe several times
- Used arms for balance
- stopped while walking
- Steps off line
- Incorrect number of steps, took more then 9 steps on the returning steps

One Leg Stand Exercise

- Swaying
- Used arms to balance
- Hopping
- Put food down

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Based on my observation, the totality of the circumstances, and my training experience, I suspected Mr. Hamideh's normal faculties were impaired at the time of the crash. At approximately 5:04 pm Mr. Hamideh was placed under arrest for the above offense and handcuffed behind his back. After being searched he was placed in the backseat of my marked patrol vehicle. Mr. Hamideh was then transported to the Palm Beach County Breath Alcohol Testing (BAT) facility. At the BAT facility a 20 minute observation period was conducted where he did not ingest anything by mouth or regurgitate. He was then asked to provide a breath test sample to test for the alcoholic content of his breath. He agreed and provided a first breath test sample of 0.000 and a second breath test sample of 0.000. I then asked Mr. Hamideh to provide a urine sample to test for the presence of chemical or controlled substances and he agreed. I read him the Florida Implied Consent drivers license suspension warning just in case he refused to provide the urine sample later. He was then read his rights from a prepared Constitutional Warning document provided by the BAT facility. He stated that he understood his rights and wished to answer the questions. At approximately 6:20 pm Mr. Hamideh agreed to provide a urine sample. Mr. Hamideh was unable to urinate. Mr. Hamideh stated he drank approximately fifteen (15) cups of water and was still unable to provide a urine sample. At approximately 8:00 pm Mr. Hamideh stated he tried his best but was unable to provide the urine sample.

At approximately 10:38 pm Mr. Hamideh was transported to Wellington Regional Medical Center for medical clearance. At approximately 11:49 pm Mr. Hamideh was transported back to Palm Beach County Jail. Mr. Hamideh was subsequently booked without incident. All of the above events occurred in Palm Beach County, Florida.

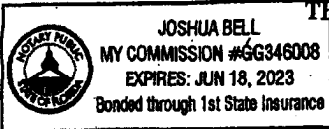
